Tighter Black Sea Wheat Supplies Disrupt Global Export Market



As Northern Hemisphere wheat harvests commence, grain markets are focused on production in the Black Sea region which has become the breadbasket of the world. Russia and Ukraine, the largest and sixth largest exporters, respectively, provide wheat to many major markets in Africa, Asia, and the Middle East. In particular, Russia’s expanded dominance in global wheat production and trade means that fluctuations in its supply situation significantly influence the global wheat market.

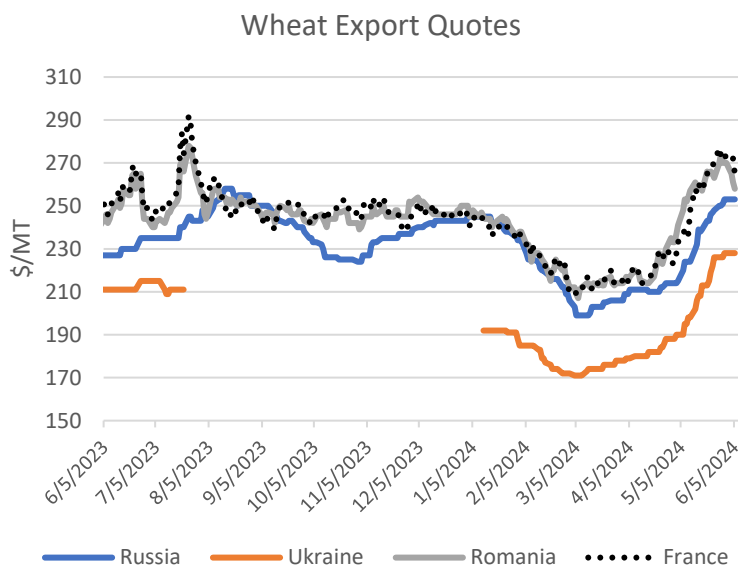
Throughout 2023/24, Russia had ample exportable supplies, with its second consecutive bumper crop augmented by substantial beginning stocks. Aided by a generous export quota, Russian export quotes were generally the most competitive throughout the year, despite efforts by the government to set a floor price. Russia’s fiercest competition was with nearby Black Sea suppliers Ukraine and Romania. Similarly, Russia has proven a stiff competitor for France in many of its traditional export markets (see [April 2024 Grain: World Markets and Trade](#)). USDA estimates that Russia will export a record 54.0 million tons in 2023/24, with Turkey, Egypt, and Bangladesh as top trading partners.

As focus shifts toward the 2024/25 market situation for wheat, the Russia supply situation is of critical concern. The forecast for Russia wheat production has been lowered to 83.0 million tons, reducing supplies by 11 percent from the prior year. A recent freeze, followed by hot, dry weather has negatively impacted the winter wheat crop. The smaller crop and tighter beginning stocks will constrain exportable supplies. Russia exports are forecast to drop to 48.0 million tons, though Russia will remain the top exporter and this would still be the second largest export volume on record.

The reductions in the Russian crop coincide with tightening supplies in Ukraine. Ukraine’s production is down significantly from the 5-year average and beginning stocks are the lowest in several years, which is

expected to result in lower exports. Ukraine exports prior to the war were nearly entirely by sea, and often to markets in Asia. Disruptions to seaborne transportation caused a shift in exports to nearby destinations (see [AMS June 2024 Ukraine Grains Transportation report](#).) The top markets for Ukraine in 2023/24 have been the European Union, Egypt, and Turkey. Meanwhile, Ukraine exports to Indonesia, Bangladesh, and the Philippines declined since the war. Australia and Russia have made inroads into those markets. In 2024/25, Ukraine exports are forecast at 13.0 million tons, the lowest in a decade.

Expectations of tighter exportable supplies from Russia and Ukraine are pushing global wheat export quotes higher. Prices among major Black Sea suppliers (Russia, Ukraine, and Romania) and key competitor France were trending lower lately, but recent downward crop revisions by various government and industry sources have been a key factor in the sharply higher export prices over much of May. Speculation about potential additional demand from India also contributed to the rally.



Ukraine and, to a lesser extent, Russia, are also significant suppliers of feed-quality wheat to the world. Wheat prices have recently risen relative to corn, making wheat less attractive for feed use. Consequently, corn may be a beneficiary of tighter wheat supplies, with shifts from wheat to corn feeding in regions that use both, including Southeast Asia and East Asia.

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The Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) updates its production, supply and distribution (PSD) database for cotton, oilseeds, and grains at 12:00 p.m. on the day the *World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates* (WASDE) report is released. 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WHEAT

OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

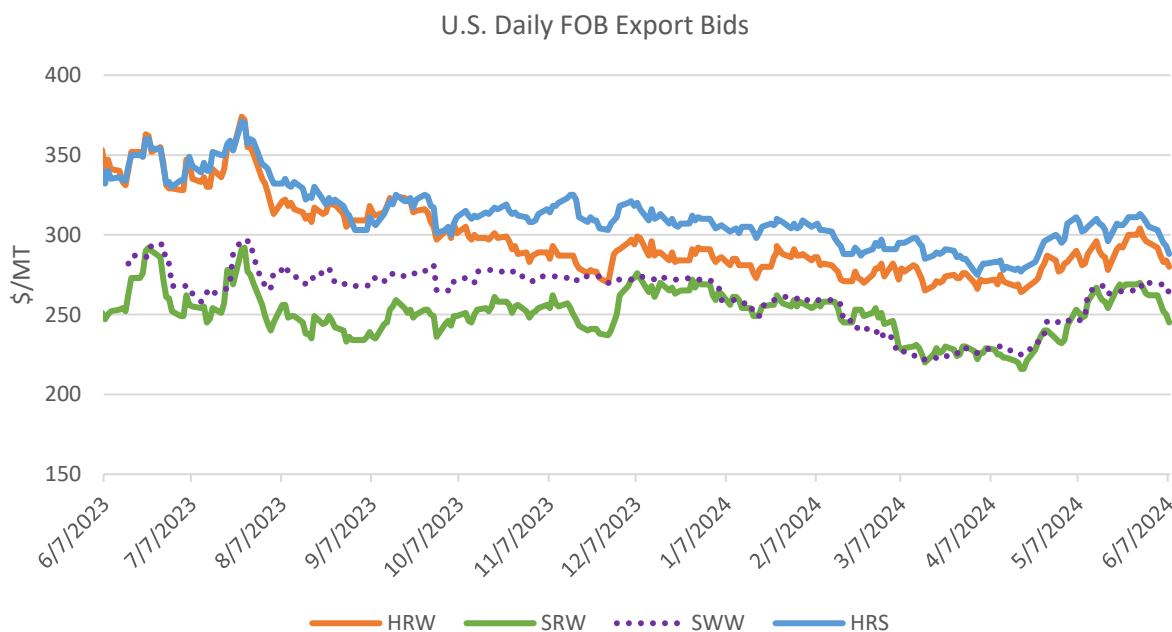
Global production is forecast lower this month, though still at a record. Production is estimated lower for Russia, the European Union, and Ukraine. Global consumption is lowered this month with reduced feed and residual use as wheat prices for feed use become less competitive. Imports are lower for the European Union and Turkey, while reduced exports for Russia and Ukraine are only partly offset by larger U.S. and EU exports. Global stocks are down this month and still at the lowest level since 2015/16. The U.S. season-average farm price is forecast up 50 cents to \$6.50 per bushel.

OVERVIEW FOR 2023/24

With minimal adjustment to production and consumption, global trade is raised to a record with imports higher this month for China, Egypt, and Brazil. Exports are raised for the European Union, Canada, Ukraine, and Russia. The U.S. season-average farm price is down 10 cents to \$7.00 per bushel.

WHEAT PRICES

Domestic: U.S. quotes were mixed since the May WASDE. Soft White (SWW) rose \$17 to \$263/ton following global trends for soft wheat. Meanwhile, Hard Red Spring (HRS) fell \$20 to \$288/ton with swift planting progress and improved conditions in the Northern Plains compared to the prior year. Hard Red Winter (HRW) (\$280/ton) and Soft Red Winter (SRW) (\$245/ton) both dipped \$6 on early harvest results. The winter wheat crop is rated 47 percent good-to-excellent condition, compared to 38 percent at the same time last year.

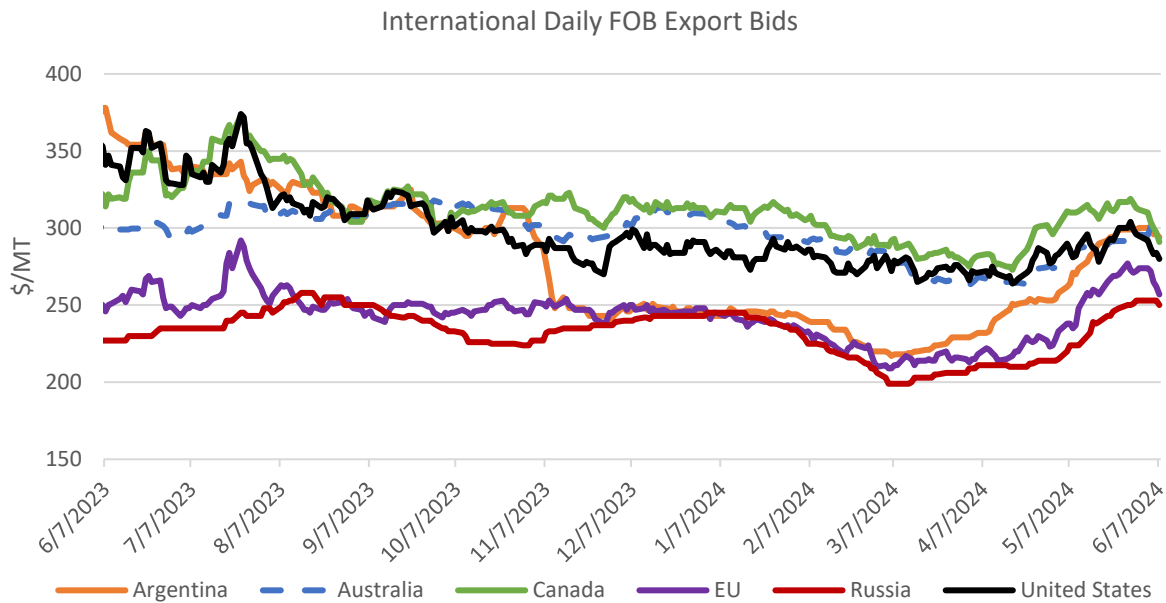

Global: Since the May WASDE, Russian quotes increased \$26/ton, reflecting concerns about the impact of unfavorable weather affecting its winter wheat crop. EU quotes rose \$19/ton on concerns about the upcoming crop, particularly in France. Argentine quotes jumped \$30/ton as exportable supplies dwindle with producers holding stocks to await better prices. Similarly, Australian prices rallied \$17/ton reflecting seasonally lower supplies and tighter Black Sea supplies which compete in Asian markets. Canadian quotes fell \$19/ton with favorable weather conditions. U.S. quotes were down \$6/ton with the onset of the winter wheat harvest.

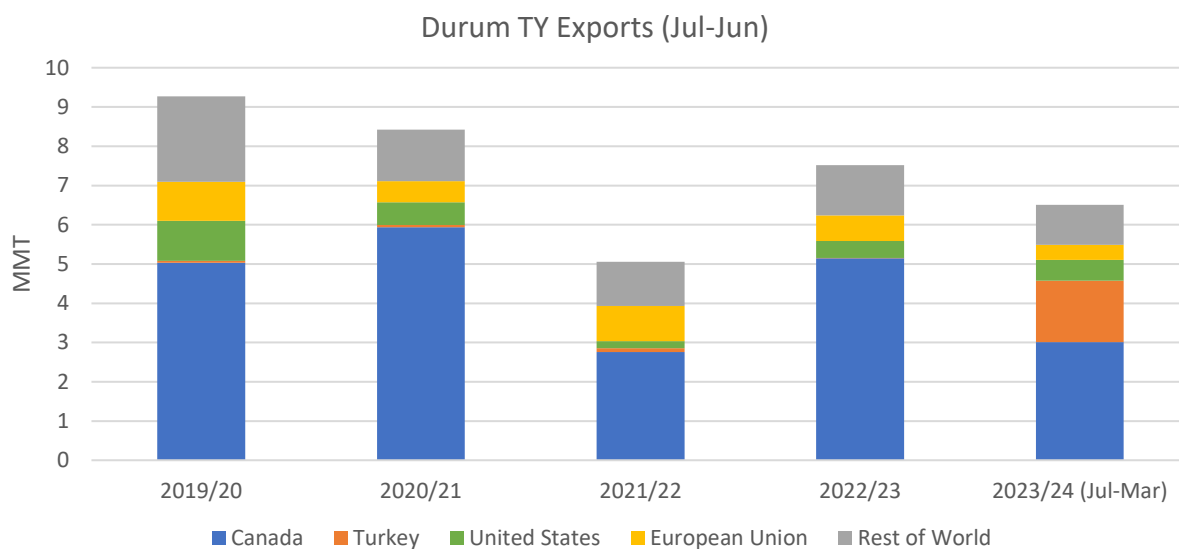

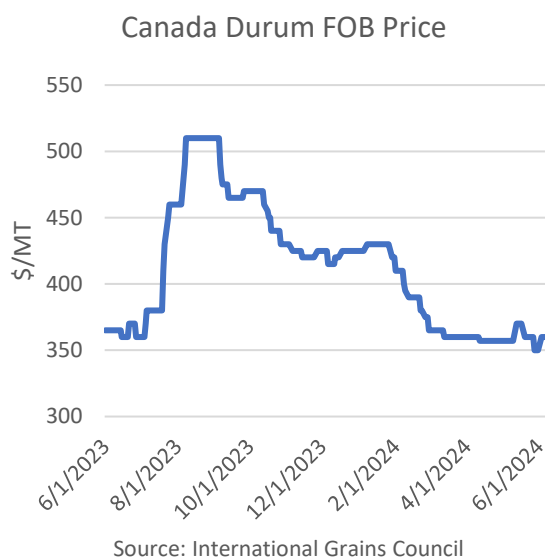
Canada's Durum Dominance Uprooted in 2023/24, Recovery Expected in 2024/25



Canada is traditionally the largest global exporter of durum wheat, accounting for more than 50 percent of world exports during most years. However, Canada's drought-affected crop in 2023/24 allowed Turkey to transform into a major durum exporter to meet global demand.¹ During the first 9 months of the trade year, Canada's global market share plummeted to 43 percent from 70 percent in the same period last year.

Canada's 2024/2025 durum crop is expected to be significantly better; [FAS/Ottawa](#) forecasts that production will recover to 5.5 million tons, a 36-percent increase year over year. This is primarily due to yields returning to historic averages, but also an increase in planted area. Grain markets are also expecting a substantially improved harvest, as export prices for Canadian durum on an FOB basis have plummeted from a high of \$510/ton at the beginning of September 2023 to \$360/ton at the end of May 2024.

The majority of Canadian durum is exported to Algeria, Italy, Morocco, and the United States. While Morocco and U.S. durum wheat imports from Canada were minimally affected by the

smaller Canadian crop, Italy's durum imports shifted to other suppliers including Turkey, Russia, and Kazakhstan. Italian imports of Canadian durum shrunk to approximately 370,000 tons in 2023/24, down from over 1.1 million tons in 2022/23. Turkey, Russia, and Kazakhstan all benefitted from Canada's short supplies in 2023/24. Collectively, these three countries exported an additional 1.1 million tons of durum to Italy between July 2023 and February 2024 compared to the prior year. Algeria also imported less Canadian durum and substituted with imports from Mexico. Mexico's exports to Algeria increased from 171,000 tons in the first 6 months of 2022/23 to 350,000 tons in the same period in 2023/24, according to the National Chamber of the Wheat Milling Sector (CANIMOLT) and customs data in Mexico.

RICE

OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

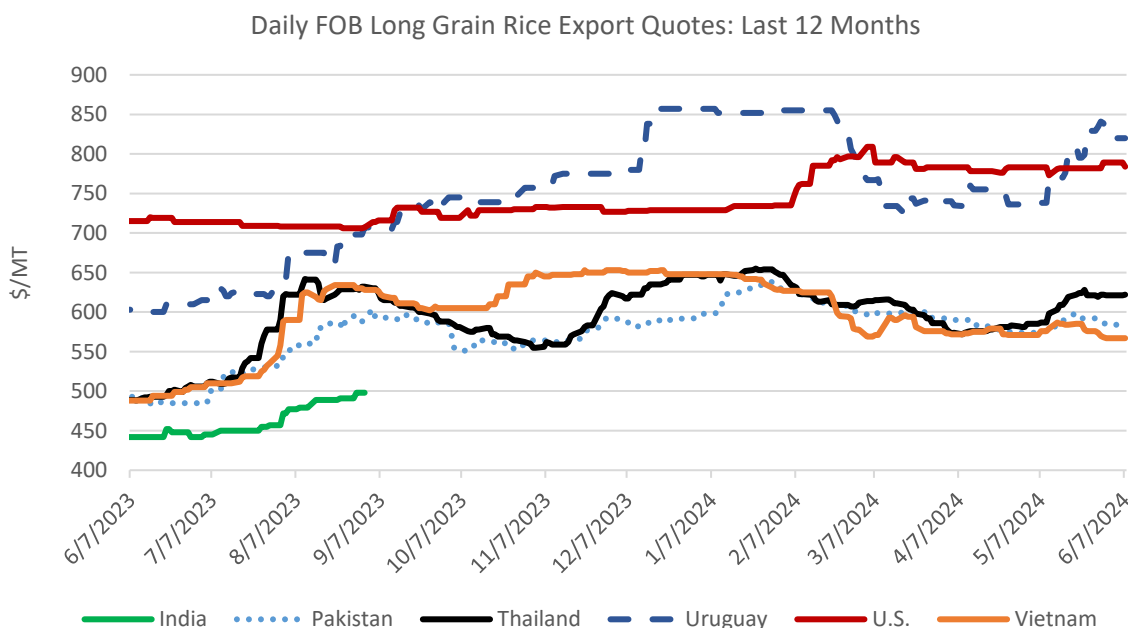
Global rice production and exports are virtually unchanged this month. Imports and global consumption are forecast higher primarily on increases for the Philippines and Kenya. Global stocks are forecast up driven by India and the Philippines more than offsetting decreases for Pakistan and Vietnam.

OVERVIEW FOR 2023/24

Global rice production is higher this month mainly on a larger crop for India. Total imports are estimated higher on increases for the Philippines, Kenya, and Iraq. Exports are up, driven by India, Vietnam, Pakistan, and Thailand. This month, global consumption and ending stocks are projected up, both driven by changes for India.

RICE PRICES

Since the May WASDE, Vietnam quotes are down, while other major exporter quotes are up. In the past month, U.S. prices increased \$1 to \$784/ton with continued strong demand from Latin America, primarily for long grain rough rice. Uruguayan quotes jumped to \$820/ton with weather-related losses for the recent harvest in Brazil and Uruguay. Vietnamese quotes declined \$9 to \$567/ton, remaining the lowest-priced supplier. Thai rice quotes increased by \$35 to \$622/ton with strong sales to Indonesia and the Philippines along with a stronger currency. Pakistani quotes moved up \$5 to \$581/ton fueled by continued sales in Africa. Export quotes for India white rice have been unavailable since imposition of an export ban for milled white rice on July 20, 2023.

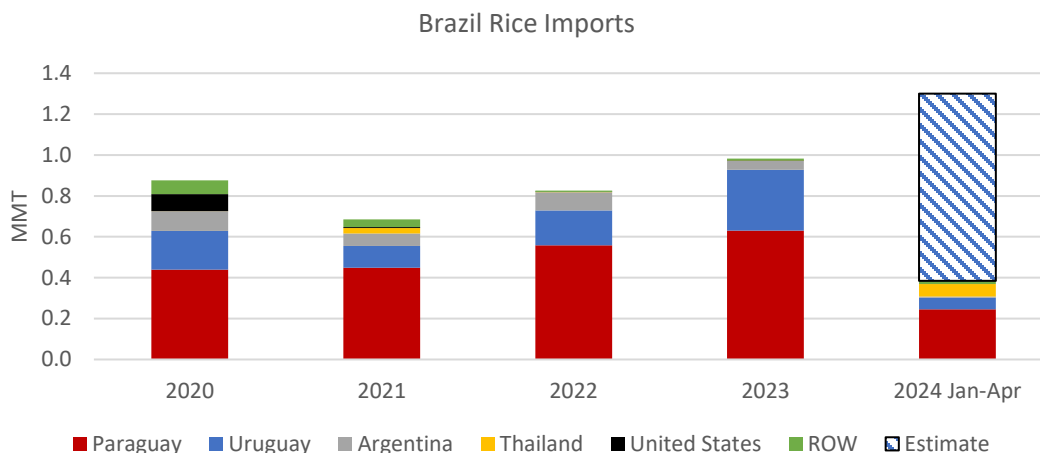

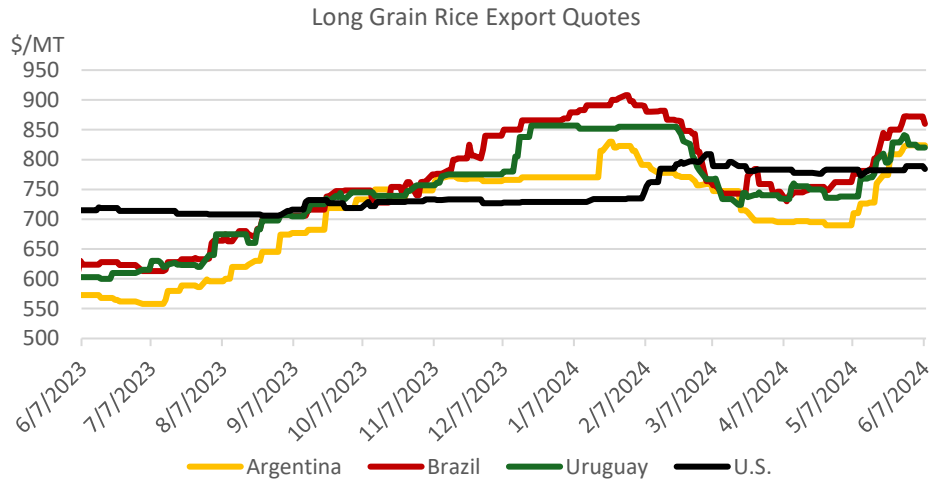
Flooding in Brazil Shifts Rice Trade Flows



Brazil, the largest rice producer within the Western Hemisphere, is forecast to import 1.3 million tons of rice in 2024, the highest in over 2 decades. Brazil rice production for MY 2023/24 (April 2024-June 2025) is revised lower to 7.0 million tons due to the impacts of severe weather and regional flooding in the southern region of Rio Grande do Sul.^[1]

In response, the Brazil government issued a suspension of import tariffs^[2] on most rice effective May 21, 2024 through the end of 2024 (see table below). The government also announced intentions to import 1.0 million tons of rice by the end 2024. On June 6, Brazil held its first auction with successful bidding of roughly 260,000 of the allowed 300,000 tons. The origin of the rice is still unclear as CONAB, Brazil's national supply company, rules stipulate that imported rice should be delivered by September 8 and in 5-kilogram packages at a capped price of R\$4 per kilogram (U.S. \$0.76).

The Brazilian government has sought to mitigate supply risks and curb price spikes, but domestic producers have expressed concern about the influx of additional supplies, particularly since the harvest only recently finished.

Traditionally, only members of Mercosur are allowed duty-free access to Brazil. Paraguay and Uruguay are the largest suppliers, with Argentina supplying smaller quantities. This new policy enables equal access to non-Mercosur suppliers. The reduction in import tariffs is reminiscent of previous interventions in 2020 which resulted in higher imports from non-Mercosur rice suppliers. In 2020, the United States exported over 82,000 tons to Brazil on a milled-equivalent basis.

Along with imports, Brazil exports are also expected to be impacted. Since 2022, Brazil has exported large volumes, capturing market share in Latin America from the United States. Brazil also expanded into Africa due to India's export restrictions. However, in 2023/24, Brazil export quotes have risen, reflecting the damaged crop. While its export quotes remain high, nearby markets may shift to purchase from the United States—now the most competitively priced supplier within the Western Hemisphere.

COARSE GRAINS

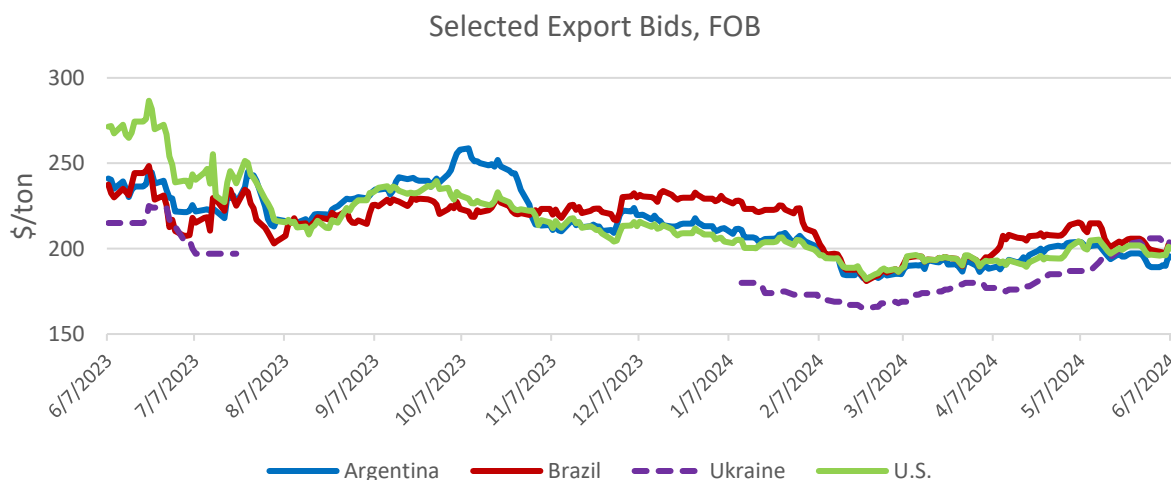
OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

Global corn production is forecast up this month, as larger crops in Ukraine and Zambia more than offset a reduction in Russia. Global trade is forecast up on higher exports for South Africa, Ukraine, and Tanzania. Global imports are up primarily on raised forecasts for several countries in southern Africa, including Zambia, Malawi, and Mozambique. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$4.40 per bushel.

OVERVIEW FOR 2023/24

Global corn production is essentially unchanged this month. Global trade is forecast up slightly on higher exports for Russia, the European Union, South Africa, and Uruguay. Global imports are also forecast up slightly as higher imports for Turkey and Zimbabwe more than offset modest cuts to Bangladesh and Nepal. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$4.65 per bushel.

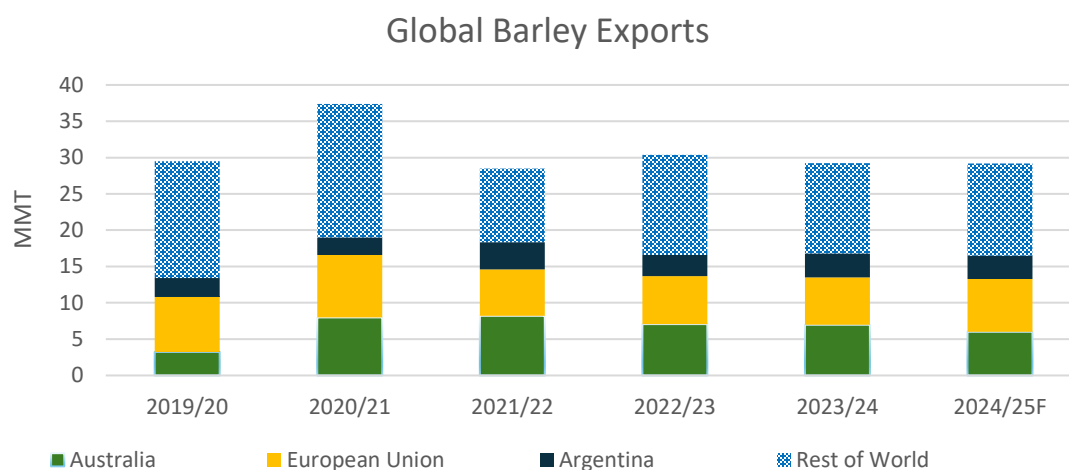

Since the May WASDE, export bids for all major exporters except Ukraine fell. Argentine bids were down \$9/ton to \$195. Amid no fresh news to corn fundamentals in Argentina, declines reflect downward pressures from other exporters. Brazilian bids were down \$12/ton to \$203. The onset of the *safrinha* harvest and supportive weather eased bids. U.S. bids were down \$4/ton to \$200. Price support from a counter seasonal surge in exports were more than offset by prospects of strong supplies due to better-than-expected early season crop conditions. Ukrainian bids were up \$16/ton to \$203 as strong export demand and seasonally declining supplies pushed prices up.

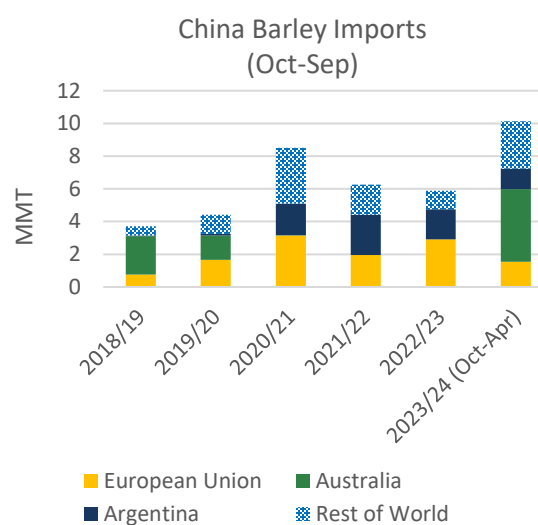
Global Barley Market Shifts Following Drop in Australia Supplies



Australia is the world’s leading barley exporter for TY 2023/24, but a decline in production has led to reduced stocks and threatens Australia’s position as the top supplier. China is the world’s largest importer of barley, and the European Union should be well positioned to gain market share in China from Australia in 2024/25.

From 2020/21 to 2021/22, Australia production jumped on increased yields, leading to consecutive years of record exports exceeding 8 million tons. In May 2020, however, China imposed anti-dumping duties on Australian barley.² After the loss of its top market, Australia only partially diverted exports, resulting in rising stocks. Despite a near 20-percent decline in area, favorable weather and yields also contributed to the large accumulation of stocks.

Production in 2023/24 declined as Australia experienced a drop in yields from adverse El Niño weather impacts. Additionally, China demand for Australian barley spiked and stocks depleted following the August 2023 removal of duties. With low carryin stocks for 2024/25, much of Australia’s production will be needed for its domestic market. Consequentially, exports are forecast at a 5-year low of 6.0 million tons.



As an exporter comprising 33 percent of China barley imports in 2022/23, the European Union has the potential to backfill the loss in the barley market left by Australia. EU production for 2024/25 is forecast at 53.8 million tons, a 4-year high. Additionally, exports are forecast to increase 12 percent year over year to 7.3 million tons. China uses barley for malting and feed, and imports increased over 40 percent

from 2022/23 to 2023/24. Despite a lower import forecast for 2024/25, large supplies are required to meet China's barley demands and the European Union is in the strongest position to emerge as the top exporter to satisfy this market.

Marketing Years (MY): MY refers to the 12-month period at the onset of the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's MY for that commodity (2022/23 starts in 2022); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the MY (2022/23 starts in 2023). Prices: Many export bids and quotes in this publication are Free-On Board (FOB). FOB is a term of sale meaning that the shipper will pay all costs to deliver and load the cargo at a specified place, usually a ship, and then the receiver pays the costs from there on — normally the ocean freight and all subsequent costs of unloading and delivery. All references to ton, unless otherwise specified, refer to metric tons – 2204.62 U.S. pounds/1,000 kilograms.

Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

Trade: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year (TY 2022/23 corresponds to Jan – Dec 2023).

EU Consolidation:

Effective January 1, 2021, the separation of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU) was complete, including trade between both entities. Starting in May 2021 with the release of 2021/22 data, field crops PSDs reflect EU27 (shown in the PSD system as “European Union”) and UK separately.

Beginning with the release of 2021/22 data, historical data for both EU27 and the UK are provided for 5 years (2016/17 through 2020/21). The trade figures starting from 1999/00 through 2015/16 represents the European Union (EU27 plus UK) and excludes all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat (1001), flour (1101), bulgur (190430), and selected pasta products (190219, 190230, and 190240) on a grain-equivalent basis (all wheat flour and products are multiplied by 1.368). (2) Rice trade statistics include rough (100610), brown (100620), milled (100630), and broken (100640) on a milled-equivalent basis (rough rice is multiplied by 0.7 and brown rice is multiplied by 0.875). (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
