

Indonesia Grain Imports to Subside after 2023/24 Record



Indonesia Grain Imports

Indonesia imported a record quantity of grains in 2023/24¹, up over 30 percent from the prior marketing year. In addition to the ongoing trends of a rising population and shifting diets, domestic production shortfalls due to delayed rainfall spurred a flurry of public and private sector purchases. However, with improved production prospects in 2024/25, imports are expected to decline.

Indonesia is a consistent major importer of wheat, with no production but a growing preference for affordable wheat-based staples such as instant noodles. In 2023/24, imports of wheat were up 38 percent from the prior year to offset tight beginning stocks. Imports of wheat for 2024/25 are expected to subside. Thus far in the marketing year, fewer imports from primary supplier Australia are partially offset by stronger imports from Canada and the United States. While imports from Ukraine are large so far this marketing year, the pace is expected to slow, given its tight stocks.

Indonesians consume more than three times as much rice as wheat, which the country typically supplies primarily with domestic production. However, with delayed seasonal rainfall, production fell in 2022/23 and 2023/24. Amid the urgency to secure staple food supplies during an election year, the state food logistics agency was authorized to import rice through numerous tenders in 2023 and 2024 to supplement supplies. While imports represented only about 10 percent of consumption in 2023/24, Indonesia rose from a minor importer to become the second-largest importer, accounting for 7 percent of global trade.

The weather also delayed Indonesia's corn harvest in 2023/24. With rising demand for feed and wet milling, Indonesia authorized additional corn imports, primarily sourced from Brazil and Argentina. Looking ahead to 2024/25, with improved production prospects, grain imports are expected to decline from this year's peak.


<u>WHEAT</u>

OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

Global production is adjusted lower this month, with cuts to the EU and Brazil, but remains a record. Global consumption is forecast down on lower feed and residual use for Ukraine. Global stocks are raised this month, led by Russia, but remain below last year's level. Trade is down with lower imports for China and Saudi Arabia. Exports are lowered for Russia and the European Union, more than offsetting higher projected shipments for the United States and Ukraine. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$5.60 per bushel.

WHEAT PRICES

<u>Domestic</u>: U.S. quotes declined for all classes since the November *WASDE*. Hard Red Spring dropped \$19/ton to \$277 on stiff competition from Canada. Hard Red Winter dropped \$14/ton to \$248 and Soft Red Winter fell \$9/ton to \$249 as winter wheat condition ratings improved significantly on widespread rainfall over the past month and strong export competition from Argentina further pressured prices. Soft White Winter lost \$5/ton at \$238 as price pressure from favorable growing conditions was softened by strong exports to East Asian markets.




U.S. Daily FOB Export Bids

<u>Global</u>: Global exporter quotes were mixed since the November *WASDE*. U.S. quotes had the largest decline of \$14/ton with favorable winter crop conditions and increased competition from Southern Hemisphere exporters. Australian quotes dropped \$8/ton as the wheat harvest advanced. Argentine quotes, now the most competitive globally, fell \$5/ton with ongoing harvest pressure. Despite announcing a restrictive export quota for the latter half of the marketing year, Russian quotes settled \$2/ton lower on slowing export demand. Canadian quotes, meanwhile, jumped \$9/ton on strong pace of shipments in recent weeks. EU quotes increased \$7/ton as Russia's export quota announcement reduced competition.


International Daily FOB Export Bids

MARKET FEATURE



Major Exporters Battle to Supply Southeast Asian Wheat Markets

Southeast Asia depends nearly exclusively on imports to meet food and feed wheat consumption needs. Imports for the region are forecast to remain strong in trade year (TY) 2024/25 (July/June), despite a slight decline from the prior year's record. Australia has tended to dominate Southeast Asian markets as the top supplier, aided by geographic proximity and production of preferred classes of wheat. However, Australian production fell by 36 percent in 2023/24 from the prior year, and buyers in Southeast Asia shifted to other supplies. In 2024/25, Australia is expected to regain some market share following a rebound of production to 32 million tons.

Australia's competition for supplying high-quality milling wheat to the region is primarily the United States and Canada. While the United States largely supplies the Philippines market and to a lesser extent Thailand and Indonesia, Canada has made significant gains in Indonesia, the second-largest wheat importer in the world.

Exports to the region from Ukraine, Russia, and the European Union soared in 2023/24, offsetting declines from Australia. These lower-priced suppliers have augmented feed-quality wheat supplies for Southeast Asia and tend to ship the majority of their exports to the region in the first half of the trade year. In the first 3 months of 2024/25 (July-September), Ukraine has been the dominant supplier, shipping over 2 million tons, while Russia has exported less than half that much to the region, and EU exports have faltered given its smaller harvest.

Australia exports to the region are expected to pick up after the completion of its harvest, currently underway, and will be complete in January or February 2025. However, Australia must now reckon with the increased prominence of South American wheat in Southeast Asia, which ships during the same peak months as Australia in the latter half of the trade year. As Argentina begins to harvest its

largest crop in 3 years, its export quotes have fallen dramatically, currently trading about 10 percent below Australia's most affordable export quote. Conversely, Brazil had made significant inroads to the Southeast Asian market but with a smaller 2024/25 crop, it will likely cede market share to Australia.



<u>RICE</u>

OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

Global rice production is forecast down slightly based on decreases for the Philippines and Nepal more than offsetting a larger Brazil crop. Global exports are forecast at a record high with increases for Cambodia, Vietnam, and Thailand. Global imports are forecast up with growth for the Philippines, Vietnam, and Nigeria. Global consumption and stocks are forecast slightly lower for Cambodia and Thailand more than offsetting an increase to Indonesia.



Since the November *WASDE*, global export quotes, aside from Thailand, continued to decline. Indian quotes are down slightly, \$2, to \$448/ton. Vietnamese quotes decreased \$9 to \$508/ton as buyers wait for the new crop harvest. Thai quotes rose \$16 to \$514/ton with strong demand from Asia and Africa. Pakistani quotes declined \$10 to \$452/ton, remaining the most competitive following India. U.S. prices dropped \$12 to \$732/ton and Uruguayan quotes fell \$57 to \$708/ton on weaker sales to Latin America.

MARKET FEATURE

Pakistan Rice Exports to Haiti Threaten U.S. Market Share


Haiti's primary rice supplier has long been the United States. So far this year, over 10 percent of total U.S. rice exports were shipped to Haiti, the largest destination for U.S. long grain milled rice. As recently as 2019, the United States supplied 95 percent of Haiti's total rice imports. However, since 2023, competition from Pakistan has increased, reducing U.S. market share to 71 percent year to date (January-September 2024).

As an outcome of Haiti's worsening socio-economic crisis and high U.S. prices, Haitian importers have sought alternative rice suppliers. In response to lower long-grain production in the United States in 2023 and soaring prices, Haiti began importing rice from Pakistan. At the same time, a 25-percent currency devaluation of the Pakistani rupee in January 2023 made Pakistan rice even more attractive. These purchases continued to be supported in 2023 by appreciation of the Haitian

gourde versus the Pakistani rupee. Furthermore, Pakistan supplies bagged rice via containers, thereby accelerating an increase in exports to Haiti during 2023. Despite an increase in availability of long-grain rice in the United States in 2024/25, Haiti imports from Pakistan are expected to remain strong.

COARSE GRAINS

OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

Global corn production is forecast down this month. Lower production in the European Union, Indonesia, and Mexico more than offset an increase to Ukraine. Global trade is forecast up marginally as increases to Canada and the United States outweigh lower exports for Brazil and the European Union. Global imports are also up marginally. Raised imports for Bangladesh, the European Union, Iran, and Mexico offset cuts to China. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$4.10 per bushel.

Since the November *WASDE*, exports bids for all major origins eased somewhat with few substantial market developments and generally favorable conditions for crop development in South America. U.S. bids were down \$5/ton to \$205 reflecting greater availability of new crop supplies. Argentina and Brazil supplies were down \$1/ton and \$2/ton to \$207 and \$217 respectively, reflecting weaker demand for seasonally dwindling supplies. Ukraine bids fell \$2/ton to \$213, largely tracking movements in other supplies.

MARKET FEATURE



Indonesia Corn Imports Trending Positive Despite Restrictive Import Policies

In 2023/24, Indonesia corn imports reached their highest level since 2014/15 despite policies in place prioritizing the procurement of domestic corn. Ending the year (Oct-Sep) at 1.8 million tons, 2023/24 imports nearly doubled from the previous year due to increased local consumption, primarily for use by the wet milling industry. This year-to-year increase represents a particularly strong period of growth, but Indonesia corn imports have trended more steadily positive since import restrictions caused quantities to plummet in 2015/16.

The Government of Indonesia (GOI) implemented import restrictions on corn for feed mills during the first half of 2016, causing overall imports to dive from approximately 3.5 million tons in 2014/15 to well under 2.0 million tons in 2015/16. Regulations limit imports for feed to procurement agreements facilitated by the government. Volumes are allotted in prescribed months based on domestic production's ability to meet feed demand, which has seen rapid growth in the last several decades, particularly for poultry. In 2023/24, the GOI authorized the import of 750,000 tons of feed corn, all designated for small holder poultry farmers.

Aside from feed, a growing percentage of Indonesia corn imports are food-grade corn for the wet milling industry to produce corn starch. As local corn exceeds Indonesia's maximum levels for aflatoxins, the private sector is permitted to import corn for industrial purposes. Demand is steadily growing from the wet milling industry, and most Indonesia corn imports since 2015/16 fall under the category of industrial use.

Total corn consumption is expected to marginally increase in 2024/25, forecast at 14.3 million tons due to increased demand from the wet milling sector. Production is also forecast to increase slightly year-over-year to 12.8 million tons in 2024/25 on higher yields. Higher domestic supplies will more than satisfy growth in domestic feed consumption, weakening overall demand for imports despite growing demand in the wet milling industry. Therefore, 2024/25 total imports are forecast to decline year-to-year by nearly 38 percent to 1.1 million tons.

<u>Marketing Years (MY)</u>: MY refers to the 12-month period at the onset of the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's MY for that commodity (2022/23 starts in 2022); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the MY (2022/23 starts in 2023). <u>Prices</u>: Many export bids and quotes in this publication are Free-On Board (FOB). FOB is a term of sale meaning that the shipper will pay all costs to deliver and load the cargo at a specified place, usually a ship, and then the receiver pays the costs from there on — normally the ocean freight and all subsequent costs of unloading and delivery. All references to ton, unless otherwise specified, refer to metric tons – 2204.62 U.S. pounds/1,000 kilograms.

<u>Stocks:</u> Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

<u>Consumption</u>: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

<u>Trade:</u> All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year (TY 2022/23 corresponds to Jan – Dec 2023).

EU Consolidation:

Effective January 1, 2021, the separation of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU) was complete, including trade between both entities. Starting in May 2021 with the release of 2021/22 data, field crops PSDs reflect EU27 (shown in the PSD system as "European Union") and UK separately.

Beginning with the release of 2021/22 data, historical data for both EU27 and the UK are provided for 5 years (2016/17 through 2020/21). The trade figures starting from 1999/00 through 2015/16 represents the European Union (EU27 plus UK) and excludes all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat (1001), flour (1101), bulgur (190430), and selected pasta products (190219, 190230, and 190240) on a grain-equivalent basis (all wheat flour and products are multiplied by 1.368). (2) Rice trade statistics include rough (100610), brown (100620), milled (100630), and broken (100640) on a milled-equivalent basis (rough rice is multiplied by 0.7 and brown rice is multiplied by 0.875). (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

<u>Unaccounted:</u> This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
