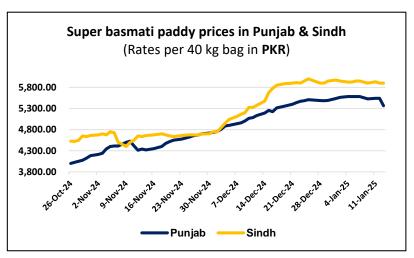


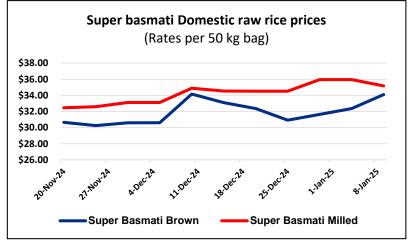

Prices steadily increased, with Punjab reaching approximately PKR 5,500-5600 by January 7, 2025, and Sindh peaking at PKR 5,950-6000 on January 30, 2025. The data provided in graphs reflects average prices reported by market. Throughout January, prices remained relatively stable with minor fluctuations.</li> <li>Although the domestic raw rice prices were stable through out showing minor fluctuations.</li> </ul>

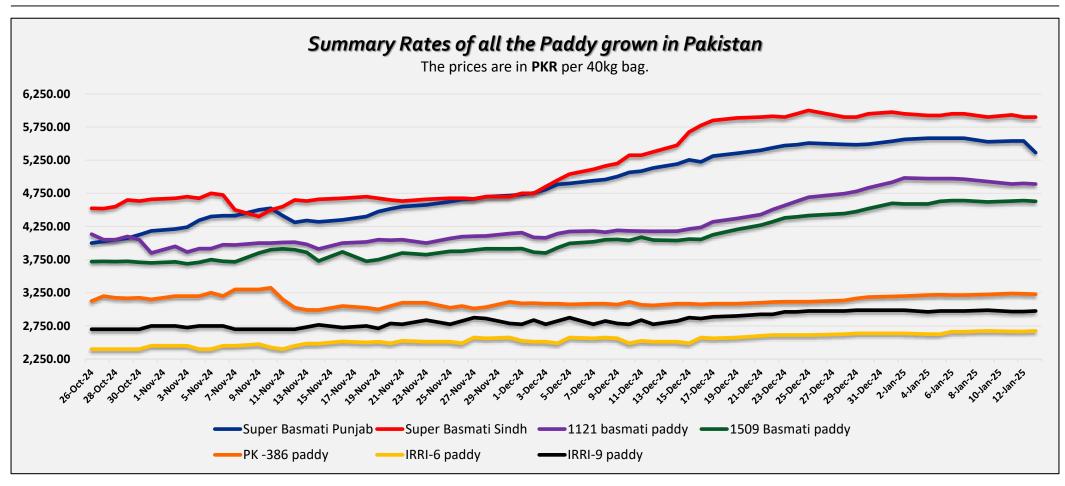

## PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- The European Union has warned Pakistan about potential disruptions in rice imports due to quality concerns, prompting Federal Minister for National Food Security, Rana Tanveer Hussain, to meet with the Rice Exporters Association of Pakistan (REAP) in Karachi. The minister emphasized proactive measures to meet EU quality standards and reassured exporters of government support. Exporters highlighted challenges, including undue pressure from government institutions and infrastructure gaps, and urged granting industry status to the rice export sector. The minister also encouraged adopting modern technologies to enhance global competitiveness. Read More (11th Jan).
- Pakistan's rice exports are facing setbacks due to quality issues, including a rejected shipment to Italy in October 2024 and EU concerns over pesticide residues. Inadequate testing and regulatory lapses have worsened the situation, while local markets face allegations of arsenic contamination and plastic rice. Lawmakers urged the creation of a national food safety policy, improved lab testing, and farmer education to meet global standards and avoid future export rejections. Read More (9th Jan).
- The Trading Corporation of Pakistan (TCP) received 11 bids for exporting 50,000 metric tons of long-grain white rice (IRRI-6) to Bangladesh, following an international tender issued on December 31, 2024. The lowest CIF bid was \$498.40 per metric ton by M/s Kap Impex, while other bids ranged up to \$523.50 per metric ton. No bids were received for 50,000 metric tons of non-basmati parboiled rice. TCP is currently evaluating the bids and will finalize the decision soon. Read More (7th Jan).
- The Malaysian government is exploring rice imports from Pakistan to address supply and pricing issues, with 28 exporters offering 100,000 tones. Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim supports the proposal but seeks further evaluation on pricing. Additionally, measures like a single price grade for rice are being considered to prevent price manipulation. Read More (1st Jan).

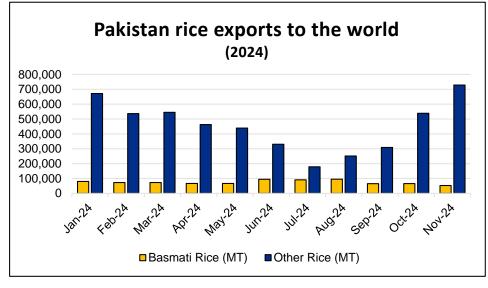

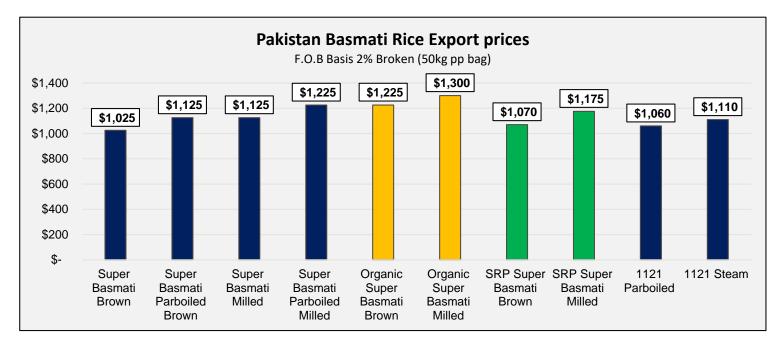

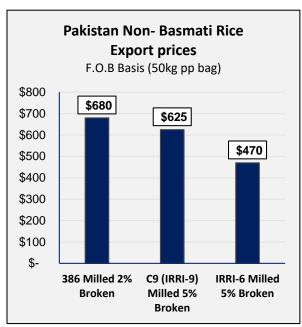

The Pakistani rice market is showing a bearish trend, with prices for various Basmati rice grades declining. Conventional, SRP and organic Super Basmati Rice, as well as 1121 varieties, have seen reductions in past weeks. Although Non- Basmati rice varieties seems to be stable. Overall, the market remains subdued with downward pressure on prices.

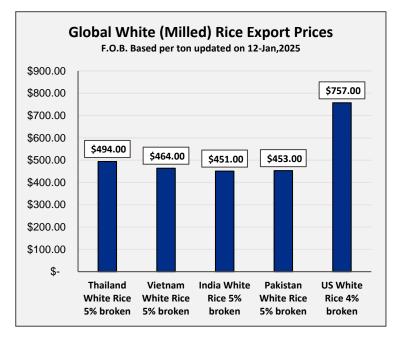


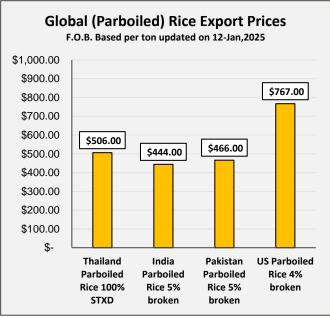


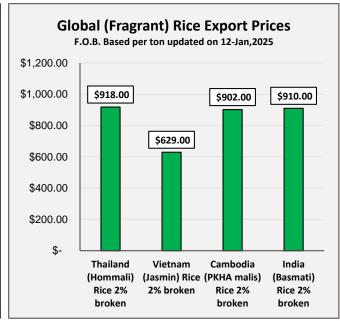












All Prices were updated on 12th January 2025.

As of January 2025, rice prices have seen adjustments across different types. 5% broken white rice experienced fluctuations, with Vietnam, Thailand, and India showing variations. In the 5% broken parboiled rice category, prices for Pakistan, Thailand, and the US differed. Similarly, 2% broken fragrant rice prices varied between Cambodia, Thailand, and Vietnam. Overall, the market is reflecting a bearish trend with weak demand and increased competition impacting pricing across regions.

## GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:



Vietnam's rice prices have hit a four-year low at \$434 per ton, pressured by reduced demand from key buyers and competition from India's cheaper exports. Global rice production is projected to hit a record 530 million tons in 2025, intensifying market challenges.

Thailand's rice exports are forecasted to decline by 25% in 2025 to 7.5 million tons, down from 10 million tons in 2024, due to increased competition from India and reduced demand from Indonesia. Despite a strong performance in 2024, Indonesia plans to cease rice imports in 2025, focusing on domestic procurement as its rice output is projected to grow to 32.8 million tons. The Philippine Department of Agriculture urges traders to import more 25% broken rice to provide affordable options, as rice prices remain high. KADIWA stores and programs are expanding nationwide, offering subsidized rice and basic goods to assist consumers. Efforts also focus on boosting farmer productivity and profitability. Bangladesh's rice market struggles with price hikes and supply issues due to weather-induced crop losses, hoarding, and low imports.
