




Supply and Demand	It is reported that, the Super Basmati paddy market in Sindh is currently exhibiting a soft trend, with prices ranging between <b>PKR 4,400</b> and <b>PKR 4,600</b> . Physical trade remains sluggish, as Super Basmati is primarily exported to the <b>EU and UK</b> , where demand has stalled due to high price levels. Current market offers are reported at \$1,000 to \$1,050 per metric ton, creating a deadlock in trade activity. Industry stakeholders are now looking ahead to the <b>Gulf Food Fair</b> , scheduled for February 17–23, as a key platform for buyers and suppliers to convene and address challenges on both ends. It is anticipated that this event will help facilitate discussions and potentially revive trade activity in the sector.

However, domestic raw rice prices experienced a slight decline, dropping from \$23.5 to \$22.9 this week. The market continues to display mixed trends, with steady paddy prices and a softening in domestic rice rates. Despite this, adequate rice stocks remain available for export, ensuring a consistent supply for international buyers.








Supply and Demand	It is reported that ample stocks of long-grain non-Basmati varieties, particularly IRRI-6, are available and expected to see a rise in trade activity in the upcoming weeks or months. This follows Bangladesh's recent tender to purchase 50,000 tons of IRRI-6 rice from Pakistan.  Although the Paddy shows a downward trend in prices and domestic raw rice prices were stable.

## PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- Pakistan's rice exports surged by 14.50% year-on-year to \$1.87 billion in the first half of FY 2024-25, driven by a 30.62% increase in basmati rice volume (416,491 tones) valued at \$433.82 million and a 13.47% rise in non-basmati rice value (\$1.44 billion). New markets, including Bangladesh, and strong demand from the EU and UK fueled growth. However, domestic basmati prices rose sharply from Rs150 to Rs400 per kilogram, straining local consumers. Read More (24th Jan).
- Pakistan's rice exports grew by 19% in the first half of FY25, reaching 3.06 million tons worth \$1.87 billion, despite global trade challenges and intense competition. Basmati exports rose 30.4% to \$433.81 million, driven by strong demand for premium quality. Exporters project \$4.5 billion in exports by FY-end, supported by favorable planting conditions, new agreements, and market diversification. Plans to enhance quality through an analytical lab and exploration of African markets aim to sustain growth. Read More (23rd Jan).
- Experts call on companies entering Pakistan's agriculture sector to focus on food security, lower crop prices, and support small farmers with climate-resilient seeds and technology. Critics warn against exploitative practices and prioritizing exports over local needs. Cooperative farming is proposed as a fair solution to boost productivity and economic growth. Government support and GMO seeds are key to bridging yield gaps and tackling climate challenges. Read More (23<sup>rd</sup> Jan).
- Federal Minister Rana Tanveer Hussain assured the Senate that Pakistan's rice exports are on track to surpass last year's \$4 billion, with minor concerns already resolved. The government is actively supporting exporters and farmers through consultations and best practices. Efforts aim to boost agricultural exports and address the trade deficit. 




## PAKISTAN RICE PRICES:

All Prices were updated on 24th January 2025.

The Pakistani rice market has seen a significant shift this week, with prices for Super Basmati varieties, including conventional, SRP, and organic grades, rising by \$20 across all categories. In contrast, 1121 variety prices have experienced a slight decline of \$5. Non-Basmati rice prices have also dropped, with IRRI-9/C-9 falling by \$15 and IRRI-6 experiencing a \$20 decrease. Overall, the market remains subdued, with notable price increases in Super Basmati and declines observed in non-Basmati varieties.

EXPORT PRICES F.O.B BASIS (PER TON)





















All Prices were updated on 26th January 2025.

As of *January 26, 2025*, rice prices have further decreased across various categories. In the white rice segment, prices for the US dropped by \$17, while Vietnam experienced a decrease of \$9. For parboiled rice, India recorded a \$4 decrease, while Pakistan's prices dropped by \$10. In the fragrant rice segment, Vietnam's Jasmine rice saw a significant decline of \$25, whereas Thailand's Hom Mali rice prices rose by \$23. Overall, the market continues to reflect a bearish trend, with heightened competition influencing price movements across regions.

## GLOBAL RICE TENDER:

#### Recent Rice Procurement Efforts and Trade Initiatives in Bangladesh.

- 1. Bangladesh has approved the purchase of 50,000 tonnes of white rice from Pakistan at \$499 per tonne under a government-to-government deal.
- 2. The food ministry is speeding up rice procurement, aiming for 6 lakh tonnes via international tenders, with 3 lakh tonnes already tendered.
- 3. Discussions with India, Vietnam, and Myanmar are underway to procure additional rice, while the public rice stock is 8.2 lakh tonnes as of January 12.

#### Mauritius tenders to buy 8,000 metric tons rice, traders say.

- 1. Mauritius' state purchasing agency has issued a tender for 8,000 metric tons of long grain white rice from optional origins.
- 2. The rice is required for delivery between April 1 and June 30, with a price offer deadline set for February 4.







## GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:



Aromatic rice production in Bangladesh nearly doubled from 5.79 lakh tonnes in 2017-18 to 10.23 lakh tonnes in 2023-24, driven by profitability, demand, and favorable conditions. However, exports have slowed due to a ban, with earnings dropping to \$0.06 million in 2023-24. Farmers face challenges with limited export opportunities and price gaps, while concerns persist about balancing aromatic and coarse rice cultivation. READ MORE (26-Jan)



Vietnam's rice exports to Singapore rose 28.45% in 2024 to S\$128.9 million, capturing 28.25% of the market. Despite leading in fragrant and glutinous rice categories, Vietnam lost its top spot to India and Thailand by year-end due to limited white rice export growth and weaker promotional efforts. Enhanced marketing is recommended to regain competitiveness. READ MORE (23-Jan)



India's rice exports in 2024 remained stable, with basmati shipments rising 16.3% to a record 5.7 million tonnes, offsetting a 6.9% decline in non-basmati exports. Despite export curbs, strong demand in the December quarter helped maintain export levels, supporting global rice prices and reducing India's stockpiles. READ MORE (23-Jan)



The Philippine Department of Agriculture is partnering with major retail chains to distribute affordable rice, starting in Metro Manila, at P29 per kilo for vulnerable sectors. The initiative aims to stabilize rice prices and may expand to other regions. Additionally, the National Food Authority will sell rice to local governments at P36 per kilo starting February 2025. Sri Lanka's rice crisis, with skyrocketing prices and red rice shortages, stems from unreliable government data on rice production and demand. Government initially underestimated the required stock, leading to excessive imports. Price controls and protectionist policies have exacerbated the problem, while experts suggest a market-driven approach could stabilize the situation. READ MORE (23-Jan)


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
## **WEATHER CONDITIONS:**

## Severe Drought Threatens Pakistan's Rice Production and Agricultural Future:

The severe drought affecting Pakistan has significantly impacted its agricultural sector, including **rice** production. **Punjab, Sindh, and Baluchistan** have experienced sharp declines in rainfall, with Punjab seeing a **40% reduction and Sindh** and **Baluchistan facing drops of 52% and 45%**, respectively. This has resulted in major crop failures, particularly for rice, as the lack of water has hindered growth. The Pakistan Meteorological Department has predicted that these conditions will worsen in the coming months, potentially leading to further declines in rice production.

Farmers are struggling with the financial impact of the drought, with many small-scale rice producers considering leaving agriculture for urban jobs. The situation is further complicated by the country's dependence on the Indus River for irrigation, which is under strain due to poor water management. With rice yields predicted to be significantly lower this year, the country's agricultural future remains uncertain, especially as climate change is expected to worsen such extreme weather events.
