Moreover, the overall market in Sindh, including other rice varieties, is exhibiting a similar declining pattern, reflecting market adjustments. 






| Supply and Demand | The IRRI-6 paddy market in Sindh has experienced a further decline this week, with prices ranging between PKR 2,250 and PKR 2,300, down from last week's range of PKR 2,500 to PKR 2,550. This ongoing price drop reflects a continued downward trend in the Sindh market. Meanwhile, IRRI-6 is all set for export to Bangladesh under the recently awarded 50,000 metric ton tender. The shipment, secured under a Government-to-Government (G2G) deal at \$498.40 per metric ton, is scheduled for dispatch later this month, marking a positive development for Pakistan's rice sector and regional trade. | | | |

PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- Pakistan is set to sign an agreement with the EU on apportioning Tariff Rate Quotas (TRQs) to maintain and enhance rice exports post-Brexit. The cabinet has approved the deal, ensuring Pakistan's rice exports are not disadvantaged in the new trade framework. A similar TRQ agreement was signed with the UK in 2022. Read More (9th Feb).
- Pakistan's rice exports have stalled due to inefficiencies at the Department of Plant Protection (DPP), with delays in phytosanitary certificates stranding shipments at ports. REAP has raised concerns over unqualified appointments and corruption, which have also led to rejections from key markets like the EU, Russia, and Uzbekistan. Exporters warn that if urgent reforms aren't made, broader agricultural exports could face stricter restrictions. Read More (7th Feb).
- Pakistan will export 50,000 metric tons of Long Grain White Rice to Bangladesh under a G2G deal, with contracts awarded to M/s Kap Impex and M/s Jetlee at \$498.40 per metric ton. The shipment is set for dispatch later this month. REAP sees this as a boost for Pakistan's rice sector and regional trade. Read More (7th Feb).
- Madhya Pradesh is pushing for recognition as a Basmati-producing state under the GI framework, but the Union government remains hesitant, fearing it could weaken India's case against Pakistan's expanded claims. Despite past efforts by Narendra Singh Tomar, the issue remains unresolved, with Shivraj Singh Chouhan now leading the push. The matter is currently under review in the Madras High Court. 





The Pakistani rice market has witnessed a further decline in prices this week, with all Super Basmati grades dropping about \$20 and non-Basmati varieties decreasing by \$5. In contrast, the 1121 Basmati variety has remained stable, experiencing a \$20 increase, where prices have fallen by \$50–\$80 over the past 2–3 weeks. This downward trend aligns with the global rice price decline. The ongoing price correction is driven by intensified competition, particularly from India, impacting overall trade dynamics.

EXPORT PRICES F.O.B BASIS (PER TON)











It has been reported that the Global rice prices are showing a bearish trend:

- > This week: The white rice category (5% broken) has experienced significant price reductions from last week across major exporting countries, Thailand (-\$16), India (-\$14), Pakistan (-\$31), the U.S. (-\$25), and Vietnam (-\$9). Similarly, in the parboiled rice category (5% broken), prices have dropped for India (-\$24), Pakistan (-\$25), and Thailand 100% STXD (-\$26), while the U.S. saw a price increase of \$12.
- > As per news, Indian and Vietnamese rice export prices have hit multi-month lows due to rising supplies, currency fluctuations, and weak demand. India's parboiled and white rice prices have declined further, while Vietnam's rice prices have reached their lowest level in over two years.

GLOBAL RICE TENDER & TRADE UPDATE:

India to Supply 1 Million Metric Tons of Rice Annually to Indonesia Under New MoU

➤ India has approved an MoU to supply Indonesia with 1 million metric tons of non-basmati white rice annually for four years through National Cooperative Exports Limited, aiming to improve trade balance and boost cooperative exports.

Recent Rice Procurement Efforts and Trade Initiatives in Bangladesh.

- ➤ Pakistan will export 50,000 metric tons of Long Grain White Rice to Bangladesh under a G2G deal, with Kap Impex and Jetlee securing contracts at \$498.40 per ton; shipments are set for late February.
- ➤ Bangladesh's state grains buyer received the lowest bid of \$434.77 per ton from Agro corp. (India) in a 50,000-ton rice tender, with all offers dominated by Indian-origin rice; no purchase has been finalized yet.

Mauritius tenders to buy 8,000 metric tons rice, traders say.

- ➤ Mauritius' state purchasing agency has issued a tender for 8,000 metric tons of long grain white rice from optional origins.
- The rice is required for delivery between April 1 and June 30, with a price offer deadline set for February 4.







GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:



Rice prices in Bangladesh are stabilizing due to increased imports and subsidized open market sales. Wholesale prices have dropped by Tk2-3 per kg, though retail prices remain high. The government plans to import 10 lakh tonnes of rice, with 305,000 tonnes already imported, contributing to further price reductions. READ MORE (4-Feb)



Vietnam's 5% broken rice price dropped to \$399 per ton, the lowest in nine years, due to increased global supply following India's market return. Businesses expect further declines with Vietnam's upcoming bumper harvest. The country exported 500,000 tons in January, but overall export volume is forecasted to drop to 7.5 million tons in 2025 from 9 million tons in 2024. READ MORE (10-Feb)



A new study highlights the impact of coal emissions on crop yields in India, particularly rice and wheat, with losses exceeding 10% in some regions. Emissions from coal plants, including NO2, reduce yields up to 100 km away. Eliminating coal plants near fields could boost rice output by \$420 million and wheat by \$400 million annually. The Philippines has declared a food security emergency to curb high rice prices, despite lower global rates and reduced tariffs. The government plans to release buffer stocks to stabilize the market, with half of the 300,000 metric tons held by the National Food Authority set for gradual release. Inflation in rice prices has eased but remains a concern. READ MORE (3-Feb)



The Royal Government of Cambodia's financing initiatives have boosted rice production from 9 million tonnes in 2016 to over 13 million tonnes in 2024, according to ARDB CEO Kao Thach. The government increased its rice sector allocation to \$150 million to stabilize prices and support farmers, while ARDB has provided nearly \$500 million in agricultural loans. READ MORE (5-Feb)
