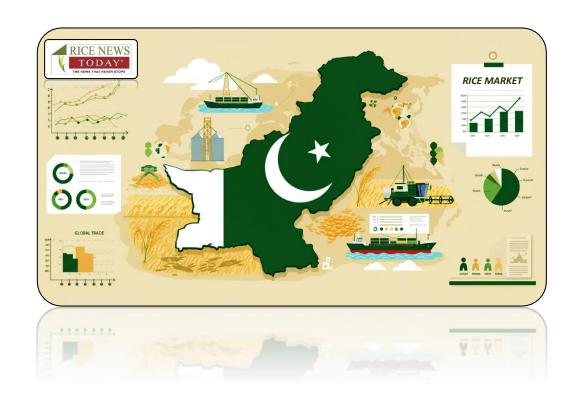

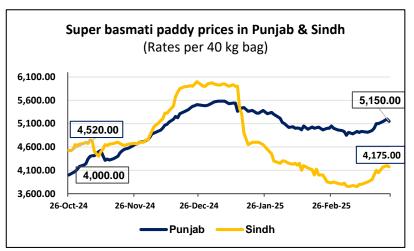


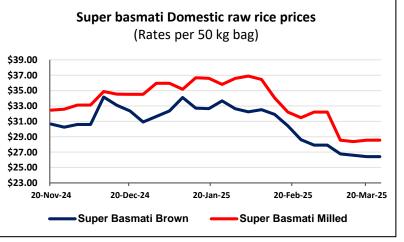

Supply and Demand	 This week market indicates that Super paddy prices in Punjab and sindh experienced a price hike. While the domestic raw rice market show a downward trend. Market sources indicate that approximately 10,000 tons of Super Basmati rice have been contracted by EU buyers in recent activity. This development signals a potential resurgence in the market, likely to be seen more clearly towards the end of April, following the post-Ramadan period. As a result of this increased demand, paddy prices remained elevated this week, suggesting upward pressure on both export and domestic market prices.

Supply and Demand	 The IRRI-9 paddy rice market remained stable this week, with fluctuations around 2700 to 2800 PKR although Domestic raw rice market prices were stable around 22\$ to 23.5\$ per 50kg. Meanwhile, the Philippines is actively working to secure white rice supplies and is seeking imports from Pakistan. To meet this urgent need, Manila aims to finalize a 1 million metric ton (MT) rice import deal by June 2025. Pakistan accounted for 11.1% of the Philippines' total rice imports, contributing to the nearly 600,000 metric tons received as of March 6.

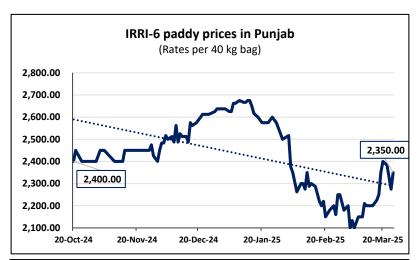


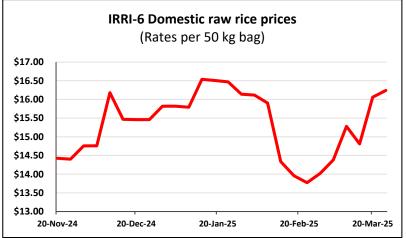

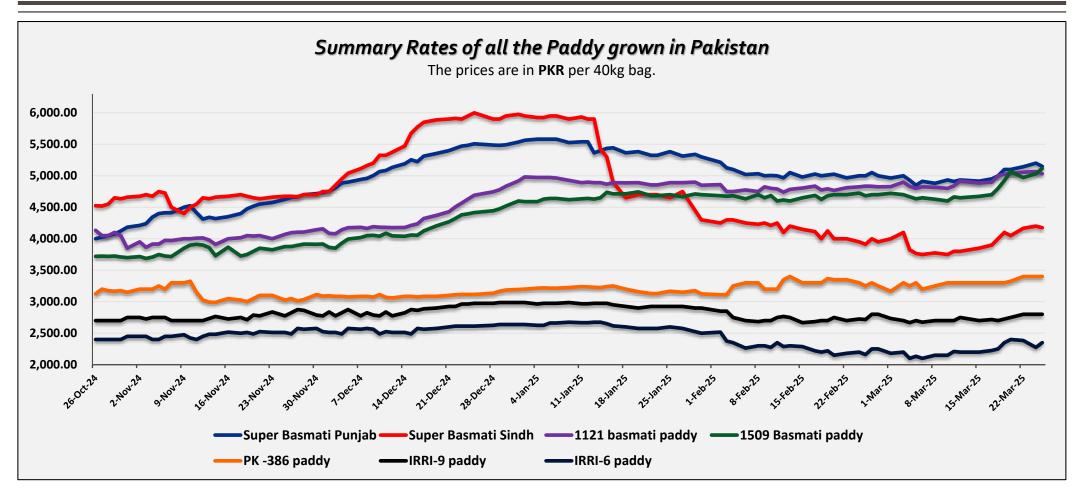

Bangladesh received the final 26,250 tonnes of atap rice from Pakistan under a 50,000-tonne G2G deal

PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- India's lifting of rice export restrictions has significantly impacted Pakistan's rice industry. During India's export ban, Pakistan gained access to key markets like Indonesia and East Africa. However, with India's return, demand for Pakistani rice has sharply declined, causing non-basmati rice prices to drop from \$850 to \$650 per metric tonne. As a result, Pakistan's rice export volume is expected to fall by 11.4% to 5.8 million tonnes by May 2024, leading to reduced revenues for exporters. Read More (25st Mar).
- Pakistan has successfully negotiated a reduction in the customs valuation of its rice exports to Kenya—from \$615 to \$460 per metric ton—enhancing its competitiveness in the Kenyan market. This achievement, led by the Trade Mission in Nairobi, is expected to boost rice exports and strengthen bilateral trade ties. The move has been praised as a major win for Pakistan's rice industry and trade diplomacy. Read More (19th Mar).
- The **ECC noted** a decline in **rice prices** on a year-on-year basis, contributing to the overall decrease in food inflation during **February 2025**. It directed the Ministry of National Food Security & Research to submit regular monthly reports on rice stock reserves. The committee emphasized the importance of maintaining sufficient rice stocks in the local market to ensure **price stability**. Read More (21st Mar).

> We learn from news that, Global rice prices continued to decline this week, with Thai 5% broken rice falling to a two-year low of \$425 per metric ton due to weak demand and oversupply. India's 5% broken parboiled rice remained steady at \$403-\$410 per metric ton, but faces downward pressure from aggressive sales by Pakistan and Vietnam. Vietnam's 5% broken rice rose slightly to \$394 per metric ton, though overall trade activity remains sluggish. Traders expect subdued demand to persist over the next few months.

GLOBAL RICE TENDER & TRADE UPDATE:

Recent Rice Procurement Efforts and Trade Initiatives in Bangladesh.

- A consignment of 11,500 tons of non-basmati parboiled rice arrived at Chattogram Port from India under package-2 to meet domestic demand. This is part of a 450,000-ton deal, with 285,769 tons already delivered. The rice import is aimed at addressing national emergency needs for the 2024-25 financial year.. (25-Mar)
- A cargo vessel from Vietnam carrying 29,000 tons of rice arrived at Chittagong Port under the G2G agreement signed on February 3. This is part of a 100,000-ton deal, with 30,300 tons already delivered. Rice sample testing has been completed, and unloading will begin soon. (22-Mar)
- ➤ Bangladesh received the lowest offer of \$424.77 per metric ton from India's Bagadiya Brothers in a tender to import 50,000 tons of non-basmati parboiled rice, following crop losses due to 2024 floods. Multiple global firms participated, and final decisions are pending. (20-Mar)
- Despite **importing 18,800 MT of rice from India** via Benapole port over the past four months, rice prices in Bangladesh remain high, especially affecting low- and middle-income consumers. **Government-authorized imports** have faced delays, and despite duty-free facilities and extended deadlines, market prices continue to rise during Ramadan. **(19-Mar)**
- Two ships carrying **35,000 tonnes** of rice from **India** and **Vietnam** arrived at Chattogram Port, with MV TANAIS DREAM bringing **22,500 tonnes** of **parboiled rice** from **India** via an open tender and MV HONG LINH 1 delivering **12,500 tonnes** of **Atap rice** from **Vietnam** under a **G2G agreement**. **(17-Mar)**

GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:



Thailand's Agricultural Market Organization (A.T.K.) plans to boost rice exports to the **Philippines by 60,000 tons** to support farmers amid falling prices. The initiative aims to stabilize domestic rice prices and strengthen bilateral agricultural cooperation, offering hope for increased farmer income and long-term market resilience. READ MORE (19-Mar)



Vietnam's rice export prices are showing signs of recovery, with prices for various grades increasing slightly after a period of decline. **High-quality rice**, which makes up **80% of Vietnam's exports**, strengthens its competitive position against India and Thailand. Experts expect further stabilization and improvement by mid-2025. <u>READ MORE</u> (22-Mar)



The **Myanmar Rice Federation** has coordinated with export companies to purchase **1.5 million** bushels of unripe rice for 140 billion kyats to address falling prices and poor demand. Additionally, discussions were held to upgrade parboiled rice mills, aiming to **export 3 million tons** of **parboiled rice** in the **2025-2026 fiscal year**, and to install solar energy systems in large rice mills. <u>READ MORE</u> (24-Mar)



ADM Rice has sold an additional **88,000 metric tons of U.S. long grain rice to Iraq**, bringing the total to **220,000 tons** for the **2024-25** period, exceeding Iraq's annual purchase agreement. This deal is crucial for **U.S. rice exports**, particularly as Iraq is the second-largest importer of **U.S. long grain rice**, a key staple in its food baskets. <u>READ MORE (14-Mar)</u>



Rice prices in Japan have surged to a record high of **4,172 yen per 5 kg**, more than double the price from last year, marking the 11th consecutive week of increases. Despite the government releasing **142,000 tons from stockpiles** to stabilize prices, the expected effect has yet to materialize, and further stockpile releases may be needed due to a poor **2023 harvest** and increased consumption from foreign tourists.
