While prices for 1121 steam rice remained relatively stable, 1121 parboiled rice saw a sharp increase, reflecting aggressive pricing in response to tight supply and robust demand.

A similar upward movement was observed in the domestic raw rice market, reflecting growing demand. Meanwhile, the Philippines white rice imports from Pakistan. To meet this urgent need, Manila aims to finalize a 1 million metric ton (MT) rice import deal by June 2025. Pakistan accounted for 11.1% of the Philippines' total rice imports, contributing to the nearly 600,000 metric tons received as of March 6.

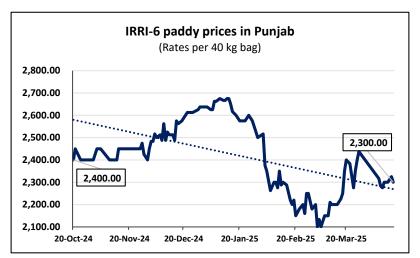


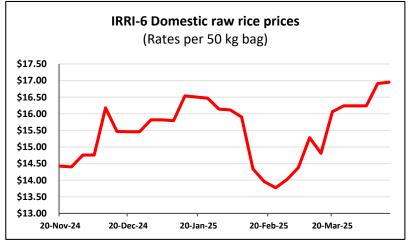

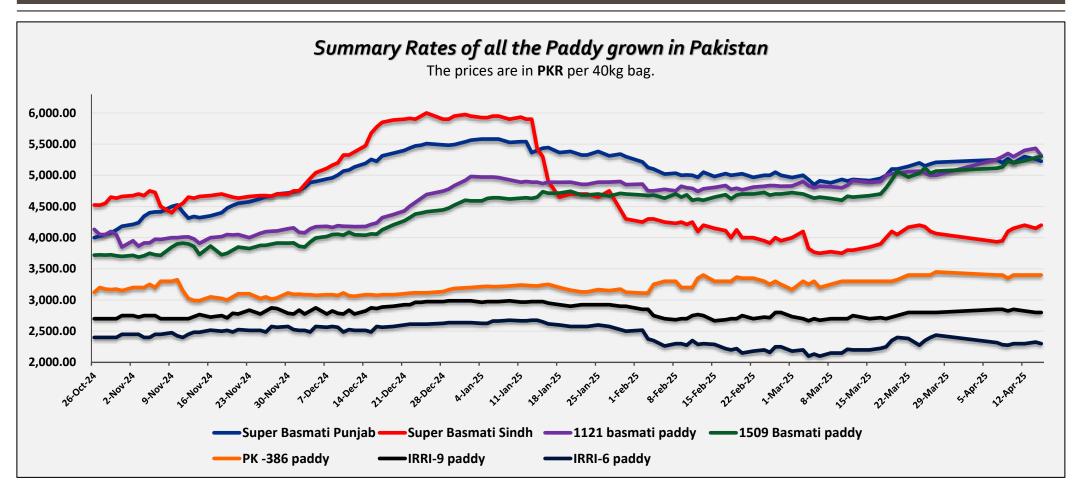

Supply and Demand	 The IRRI-6 paddy market has shown a bullish trend over the past few weeks, with prices rising from PKR 2,200 to 2,400 per 40 kg, and currently stabilizing around PKR 2,300. Domestic raw rice prices have also surged, jumping from USD 15.5 to approximately USD 17 per 50 kg, reflecting firm demand and limited availability.

PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- Pakistan's claim to Basmati as part of its cultural and agricultural heritage has been central to the ongoing GI dispute with India. While it granted Basmati GI status domestically in 2021 and expanded the claim from 14 to 44 districts, this move risks undermining geographical authenticity. Pakistan's membership in UPOV 1978 also places it under pressure to adopt stricter seed ownership regimes, which could impact farmers' rights. With increasing EU rejections of Basmati exports over pesticide residues, Pakistan must also strengthen its quality controls to maintain global market access and safeguard its share in this shared legacy. - Punjab's Agriculture Minister Syed Ashiq Hussain Kirmani announced that the second phase of the 'Kissan Card' initiative will start on May 15, offering Rs75 billion in interest-free loans for Kharif crops. Eligible farmers owning 8–10 acres will be able to use 25% of the loan for diesel and receive 30% in cash, while timely repayments will qualify them for Rs5,000 per acre support. The government also plans to distribute 10,000–20,000 subsidized green tractors in the next phase. Construction of agriculture malls in four cities is 80% complete, with ten more malls proposed. Additionally, 2,000 agricultural graduates will be recruited, and 5,000 super seeders will be distributed by September under the Smog Control Program.. Read More (17th Apr).

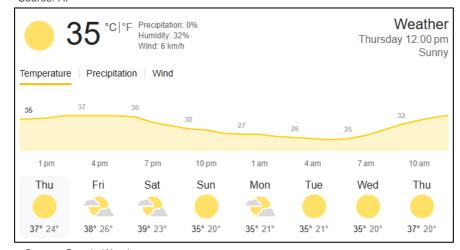
WEATHER CONDITIONS IN PAKISTAN:

Pakistan's water crisis: the cost of sugarcane and rice:

- Pakistan is edging closer to a severe water crisis that threatens its agriculture, economy, and food security. Among the most water-stressed countries in the world, it continues to cultivate water-intensive crops like sugarcane and rice. In Punjab, where agriculture thrives, over 50 million acre-feet (MAF) of groundwater is extracted annually—far exceeding the nation's surface water storage of 13.5 MAF. This overuse, coupled with erratic rainfall and inefficient irrigation, is depleting aquifers and degrading soil, putting long-term food production at risk.
- ➤ Sindh, on the other hand, suffers from excessive irrigation, leading to widespread waterlogging and salinity. Almost half of Upper Sindh's irrigated land is affected. Infrastructure like the Sukkur Barrage loses nearly 4 MAF of water yearly through seepage and inefficient distribution. Despite this, sugarcane—spread across 3.2 million acres and consuming 18 MAF of water—is still encouraged by subsidies, even though its water productivity lags behind global standards. The refining process further increases water consumption, using 1.75 cubic meters to produce just one kilogram of sugar.
- Rice cultivation presents similar challenges. With **8.9 million acres** under cultivation, it uses **14 MAF of water each year**, often due to flood irrigation. Pakistan also exports 4 million tons of rice annually, effectively sending **8.1 MAF** of virtual water abroad. Combined, sugarcane and rice account for **32 MAF** in water usage. Without adopting water-efficient farming methods and stronger policy reforms, Pakistan risks further straining its most precious resource—water. Read More

GLOBAL RICE TENDER & TRADE UPDATE:

Recent Rice Procurement Efforts and Trade Initiatives in Bangladesh.

- The MV PHU THANH vessel carrying 10,000 metric tonnes of rice from India has arrived at Chattogram Port, part of a 500,000 metric tonne import agreement, with 353,000 tonnes already delivered. Unloading will begin after sample testing. (16-Apr)
- ➤ Rice imports through Dinajpur's Hili Land Port surged ahead of the April 16 deadline, with **267,857 tonnes imported** since November, as traders rushed to bring in rice before the government's duty-free import period ends. **(15-Apr)**
- ➤ Bangladesh's state grains buyer has purchased **50,000 metric tons of non-basmati parboiled rice at \$416.44 per** ton in a **March 27** international tender, following crop damage. **(13-Apr)**
- A ship carrying **36,100 metric tons of rice from India** has arrived at Chattogram Port. The MV FROSSO K, transporting the rice via an international open tender, will be unloaded promptly. **(13-Apr)**
- ➤ Rice prices in Bangladesh remain high despite importing **820,000 tonnes since November**, with fine rice up by **11.35%** and medium varieties **by 8.85%**. Hilsa prices have surged ahead of Pahela Baishakh, with fish priced up to **Tk2,300 per kg**, while vegetable prices have also climbed. **(12-Apr)**
- A total of **5,447 tons of rice** were imported from **India** through Hili Land Port in Dinajpur on Sunday, with 126 trucks delivering the shipment. The rice import period has been extended until April 15 by the Ministry of Food, and import activities are expected to increase further. **(7-Apr)**

GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:



The US has postponed proposed tariffs on Indian basmati rice imports for **90 days**, providing relief to exporters and allowing uninterrupted shipment of existing consignments. India **exported 3.15 LMT of basmati rice** to the **US in 2022–23** and **3.08 LMT in 2023–24**, even as total **basmati exports** rose from **52.42 LMT to 59.42 LMT in 2024–25**. The extension offers a key window to finalize deals and manage logistics before the new crop arrives. READ MORE (11-Apr)



Indonesia is projecting a **rice surplus of up to 12 million tons in 2025**, with state agency Bulog already absorbing **840,000 tons** by April—a **2,000% increase year-on-year**. Backed by land expansion, infrastructure upgrades, and higher floor prices, the government aims to shift from being a top **importer (4.52 million tons in 2024)** to a global rice exporter under President Prabowo's food sovereignty agenda. Cambodia exported **211,058 tonnes of milled rice worth US\$160.5 million in Q1 2025**, with **47 companies shipping to 55 countries.** China remained a key buyer, **importing 37,821 tonnes valued at \$22.6 million**. Fragrant rice dominated exports, accounting for over **81% of the total volume.** READ MORE (14-Apr)



Vietnam is expected to **export around 4.35 million tonnes** of rice to the **Philippines in 2025**, maintaining its position as the leading supplier with a **40-45% share of the market**. Despite efforts by the Philippines to diversify suppliers and control retail rice prices, Vietnam's competitive pricing, quality, and stable supply make it a dominant player in the market. Myanmar earned over **US\$1.129** billion from **exporting 2.48** million **tonnes of rice** and **broken rice** in the **2024–2025** fiscal year, nearly meeting its **2.5** million **tonne export** target. Most exports occurred via maritime trade, with border trade contributing minimally. In contrast, the previous year saw only **1.6** million **tonnes** exported due to monetary policy and El Niño impacts. <u>READ MORE</u> (09-Apr)
