- **EU** and **UK** remain critical due to zero-duty access and preference for brown rice in retail and processing chains.
- Early FY2024–25 data (Jul–Aug) confirms 86,761 MT of brown rice exports to 32 countries, with these 10 leading the volume share.

PAKISTAN RICE SECTOR – Key highlights for (June 2025)

The following points summarize key developments in Pakistan's rice sector as reported in various news sources during June 2025:

- Amid growing quality issues and delays in inspections, the National Assembly Standing Committee urged tighter checks on rice consignments, pushing the **Department of Plant Protection** to strengthen its container protocols and safeguard trade credibility.
- **Pakistan Kissan Ittehad** sounded the alarm over a deepening **agri-crisis**, demanding fair commodity pricing and support mechanisms a move that could stabilize the struggling rice sector, which faces rising input costs and pricing uncertainty.
- Punjab launched a province-wide initiative to uplift rice productivity through mechanization, introducing thousands of seeders and transplanters while pledging stricter pesticide controls and stakeholder-driven policy planning.
- Despite India's re-entry with heavy subsidies and undercut pricing, Pakistan's rice exports remained stable at 5.54 million tonnes in FY25. But a dip in Kharif 2024 output is expected to cut Q2 2025 exports by 15%.
- Pakistan's rice exports to **China surged 121% in early 2025**, driven by demand for semi- and fullymilled varieties like **Super Basmati** and **IRRI-6** — favored for their yield, aroma, and suitability in food processing and retail.
- Ahead of the federal budget, rice prices in Rawalpindi wholesale markets jumped by **Rs400 per bag** due to reduced supply, rising transport costs, and new taxes intensifying inflationary pressure on local consumers.





"Iran–Israel Conflict Disrupts Basmati Trade: Pakistan Gains Ground as India Faces Delays and Losses"

- Escalating tensions between Iran and Israel in June 2025 disrupted vital shipping routes through the Strait of Hormuz, causing Indian Basmati exporters to panic as over 1 lakh tonnes of rice shipments to Iran were held up at Kandla and Mundra ports.
- Payment delays worsened the crisis, with nearly ₹2,000 crore stuck for previously shipped consignments and long credit cycles pushing Indian exporters into serious cash flow troubles. Rising freight costs and war-risk insurance premiums only added to their burden.
- Despite the turmoil, India's Basmati exports to Iran may still touch last year's 0.86 million tonnes, as most deals were locked in before July. However, Iranian buyers paid lower rates averaging \$746/tons in April well below prices from other markets.
- Meanwhile, **Pakistan** capitalized on the chaos, expanding its rice footprint in **Iran** through landborder barter trade involving petroleum, copper, and electricity. Without banking barriers and maritime delays, **Pakistani rice** moved faster and more competitively.
- As India grapples with pending dues and disrupted logistics, experts are urging a strategic rethinking of **Basmati trade** policy in West Asia. For now, **Pakistan's** agile response is giving it the upper hand in a traditionally **India-dominated market**.

MAJOR GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF (June 2025):



- As per the news, In June 2025, India reported record foodgrain production of 354 million tons for 2024–25, up 6.6% from last year, driven by bumper harvests of rice (149.07 mt), wheat (117.5 mt), maize, and oilseeds.
- The government credited supportive MSP policies, timely fertilizer supply, and favorable weather. Projections for 2025–26 also indicate another record season, with rice output expected to reach 151 mt and wheat at 117.5 mt, backed by steady acreage and improved yields. Despite high domestic stocks, global rice trade remained slow due to weak demand and oversupply.
- Meanwhile, Japan's severe rice inflation and structural production challenges have opened a potential export opportunity for India. With Japan planning to boost imports, India could expand beyond Basmati and supply suitable non-Basmati sticky rice varieties like Joha from the Northeast, supporting farmers and reducing the trade deficit with Japan.



- In June 2025, Vietnam's rice sector grappled with regulatory shifts and price volatility. A new draft decree proposes mandatory stockpiling of 1,250 tons and warehouse ownership for rice exporters — measures the business community warns will raise operational costs and hinder market access for new players.
- Meanwhile, export volumes rose 12.2% year-on-year in the first five months, reaching 4.5 million tones, but average export prices fell sharply by 18.7% to \$516/tones, dragging export value down 8.9%.
- Domestically, Mekong Delta paddy prices remained stable, while high-grade rice like ST 25 retained premium values. The Philippines remained Vietnam's top buyer, though import value dropped. In contrast, exports to Bangladesh surged over 500-fold, while shipments to China also rose significantly. Amid rising global supply and cautious demand, Vietnam is refocusing on high-end markets like Japan and Europe to sustain competitiveness.

MAJOR GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF (June 2025):

- In June 2025, Thailand intensified efforts to promote its highquality rice varieties, including jasmine, organic, and GI-certified types, through the 10th Thailand Rice Convention, where officials expect over 100,000 tones in export deals worth 2 billion baht.
- The government maintained its 2025 rice export target at 7.5 million tones, despite a 30% year-on-year drop in export volume and a 34% decline in value during January–April. Hom Mali and parboiled rice exports showed modest gains, while white rice and broken rice exports fell sharply.
- Meanwhile, rice shipments to China surged 77.7% in volume and 31.3% in value over the same period, driven by favorable trade terms and strong demand. Officials remain cautiously optimistic amid concerns over India's re-entry into the global market and currency fluctuations, with a strategic focus on high-purchasingpower markets like China, the EU, Japan, and the Middle East.

- In June 2025, Indonesia achieved a historic milestone by securing over 4 million tones of government rice reserves the highest in 57 years reflecting strong national food governance and improved farmer welfare.
- Agriculture Minister Andi Amran Sulaiman credited strategic policies, land expansion, subsidized fertilizers, and widespread distribution of machinery for a projected 11.17% year-on-year increase in rice production, reaching 18.76 million tones in H1 2025.
- Bolstered by this surplus, Indonesia announced 10,000 tones of rice aid to Palestine and expressed openness to regional rice export collaborations, including with Malaysia. The government views these developments as a testament to self-reliance and a foundation for broader food diplomacy.
