

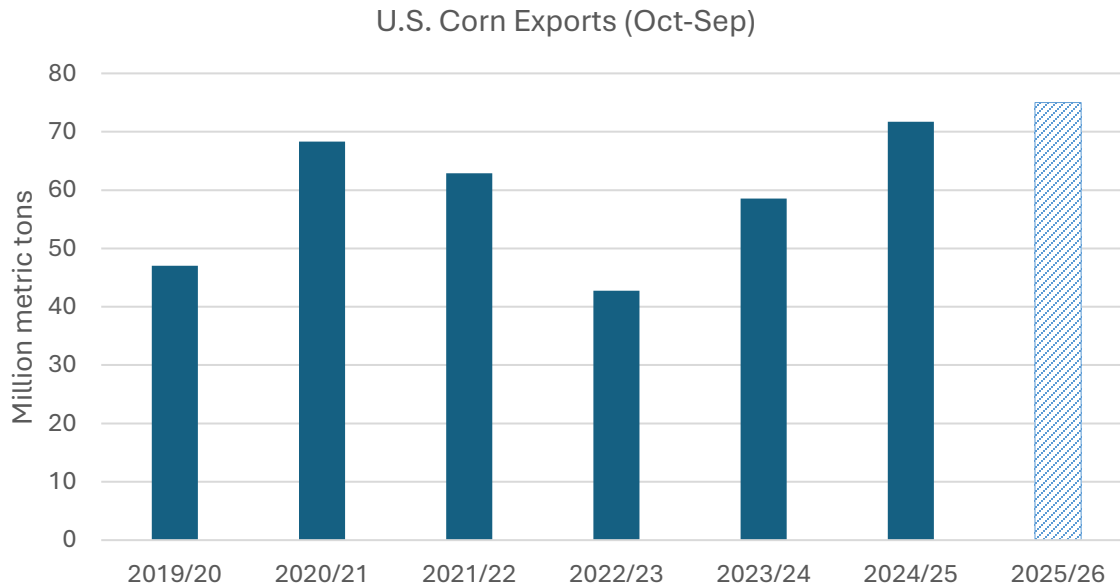

Grain: World Markets and Trade

U.S. Corn Exports Forecast at Back-to-Back Records



In 2024/25 (Oct-Sep), U.S. corn exports are estimated to hit a record of 71.7 million tons, eclipsing the previous high of 68.3 million tons in 2020/21. Exportable supplies were plentiful this year, with the fifth-largest production ever bolstered by the largest beginning stocks in 5 years. As a result, U.S. corn was price competitive throughout most of the year. In the earlier part of the season, a smaller crop resulted in lower exports and reduced competition from Ukraine. Following that, Brazil's *safrinha* (second crop) exports, which typically begin in July, are off to a slow start in 2025 despite the second highest crop, offering late season breathing room for U.S. corn exports.

Key export destinations in 2024/25 include Mexico, Japan, Colombia, and South Korea, representing over 70 percent of year-to-date U.S. export volume (Oct-Jul). However, growth in both smaller markets and countries where the United States has a smaller market share have contributed to corn's export performance as well. Export volumes to Guatemala, Vietnam, and the European Union are at the highest level in at least 5 years, if not outright new records.

U.S. corn production in 2025/26 is forecast at an unprecedented 427 million tons, and the bountiful supply situation supports a forecast for a *consecutive* record of 75.0 million tons of exports in the upcoming year, up 2.5 million from the August forecast. Per Export Sales Reporting as of the beginning of September, sales already on the books for the new marketing year are at the second highest level ever despite the absence of China demand. Though exports from Argentina, Brazil, and Ukraine are expected to grow modestly year over year – from either larger crops or moderating of domestic demand growth – the United States is poised to remain by far the world's largest corn exporter.

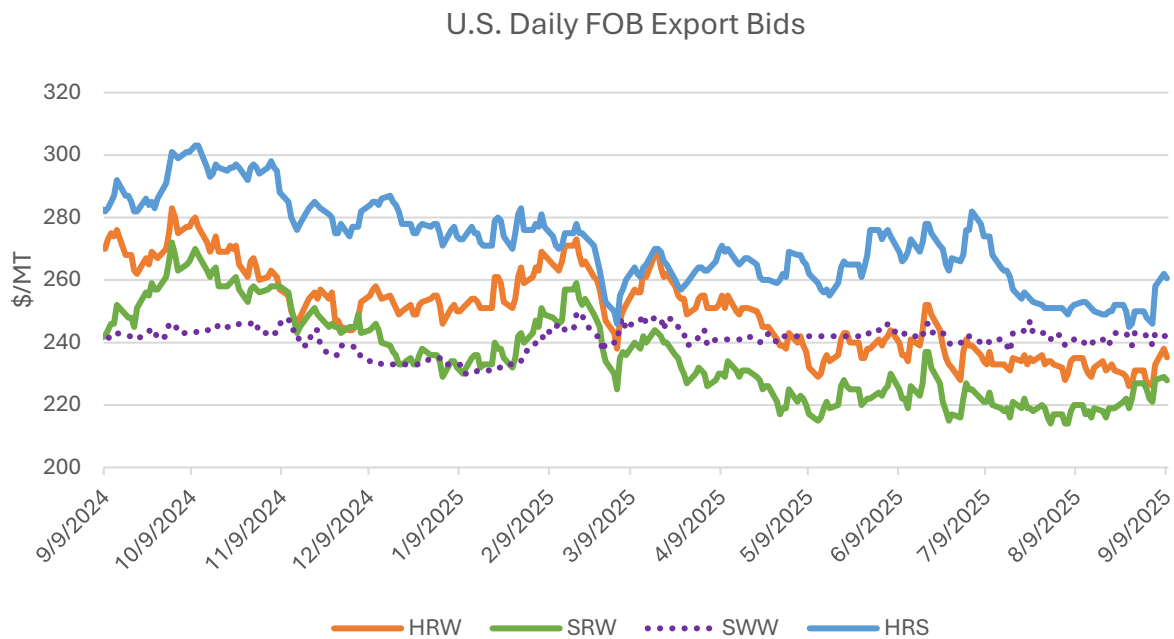
WHEAT

OVERVIEW FOR 2025/26

Global production is forecast higher this month to a new record, with increases to Australia, the EU, Russia, Canada, and Ukraine. Global consumption is raised mainly on increased feed and residual use in the EU, Australia, Canada, Russia, and Ukraine as well as smaller adjustments to food, seed, and industrial use across several countries. Stocks are boosted by larger production in several major exporting countries. Global trade is up on higher imports for Indonesia, Nigeria, the Philippines, and Brazil, mitigated by a reduction for the EU. Exports are raised for Australia and the United States, partially offset by cuts to Russia and Ukraine. The U.S. season-average farm price is forecast 20 cents lower at \$5.10 per bushel on NASS prices reported to date and price expectations for the remainder of the marketing year.

WHEAT PRICES

Domestic: Since the August *WASDE*, U.S. wheat prices rallied after months of lows with strong export sales and a relatively weak U.S. dollar. Hard Red Spring jumped \$9/ton to \$261 while Soft Red Winter gained \$8/ton to \$228. Soft White Winter (\$242/ton) and Hard Red Winter (\$235/ton) were little changed from last month.

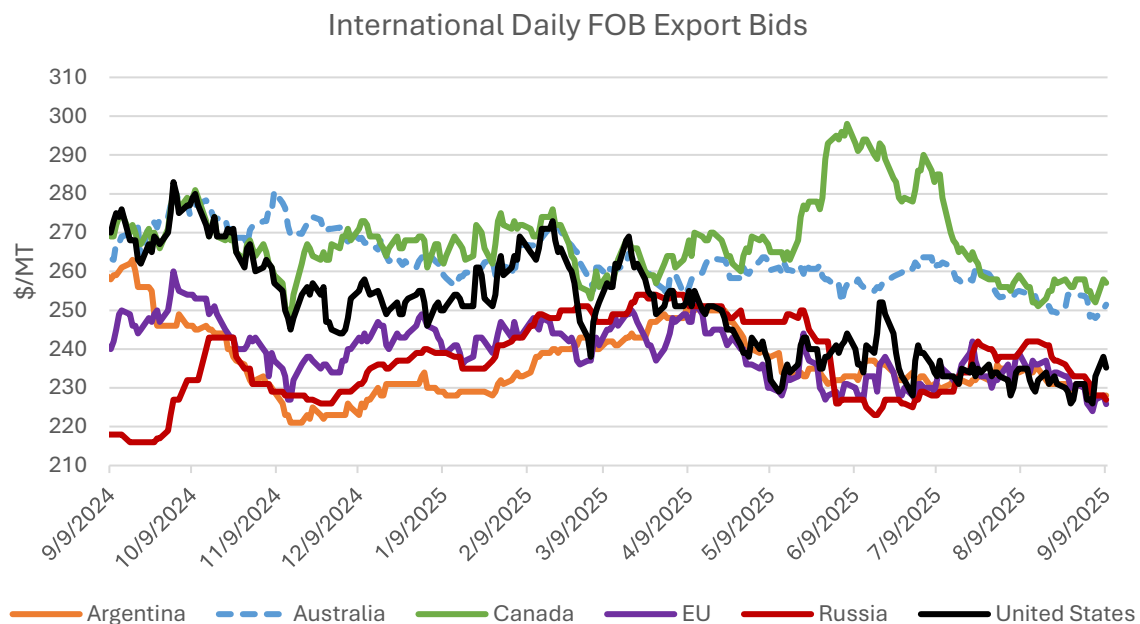

Global: Prices for all exporters except the United States were down from the August WASDE. EU quotes dropped \$13/ton on building harvest pressure and soft sales. Russian quotes fell \$12/ton on slow pace of exports. Argentina lost \$6/ton on increased pressure from global exporters. Australia fell \$4/ton with higher supplies. Canadian quotes were down \$2/ton and U.S. prices were unchanged as strong exports supported quotes despite a bearish international market.

RICE

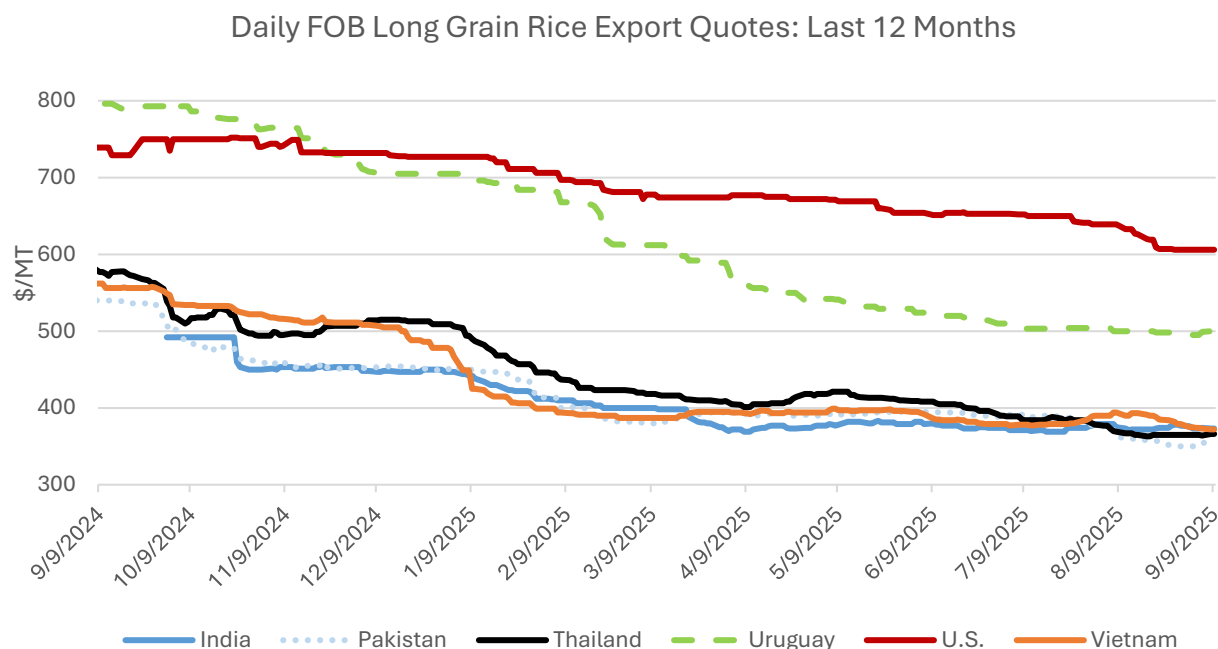
OVERVIEW FOR 2025/26

Global rice production is down from last month primarily due to a reduction for Vietnam. Global trade is nearly unchanged this month with an increase to Burma's exports offsetting reductions in Pakistan and the United States. Global consumption is up primarily in India and Madagascar. Global stocks are forecast higher with increases for Pakistan, South Korea, and the United States.

OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

Global rice production is up this month due to increases for Brazil and Colombia. Global trade is forecast lower with decreased exports from India and Pakistan. Global consumption is forecast lower, primarily in Burma and the United States. Global ending stocks are forecast higher with increases for India and Pakistan.

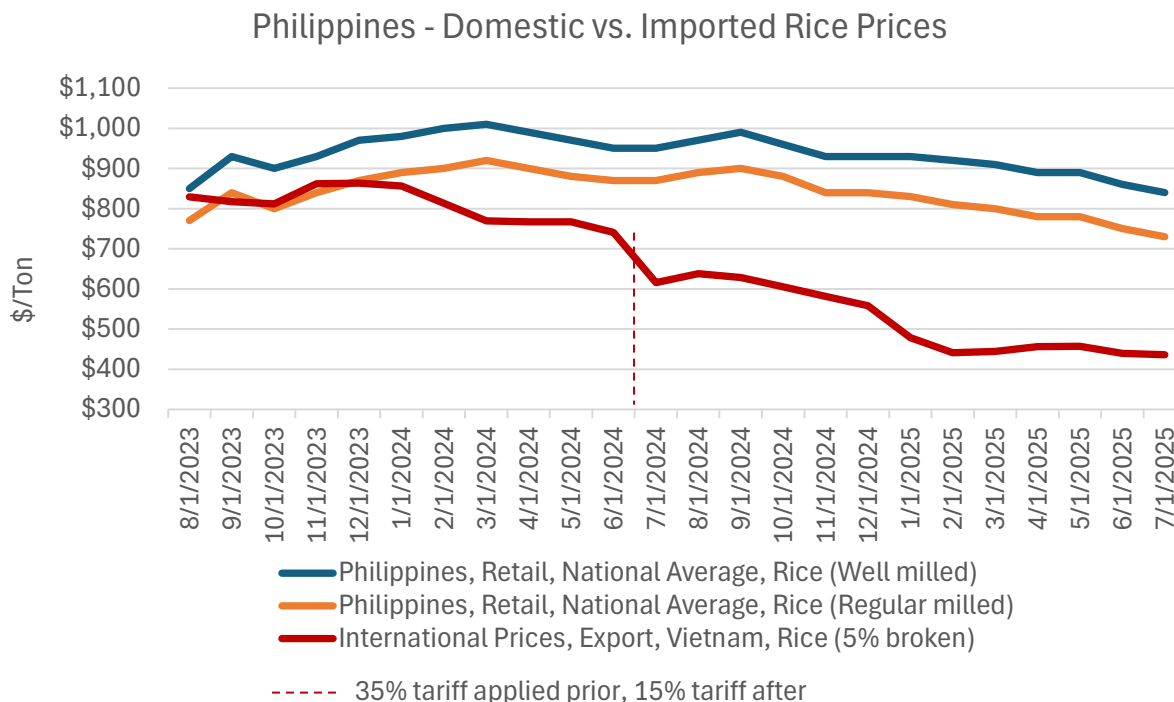

Since the August *WASDE*, global export prices declined except for Uruguay. U.S. quotes fell \$33 to \$606/ton amid the ongoing harvest. Uruguayan prices were unchanged at \$500/ton, reflecting strong demand. India quotes (\$373/ton) decreased \$2 on weaker global demand. Vietnamese quotes (\$372/ton) decreased \$22 following the temporary ban on Philippine rice imports. Thai quotes dipped \$3 to \$366/ton to garner more demand from importers. Pakistani quotes dropped \$4 to \$358/ton on weak interest from major markets.

MARKET UPDATE

The Philippines Temporarily Suspends Rice Imports

On August 6, 2025, the Philippines, the world's top rice importer, announced a 60-day ban on rice imports starting September 1, 2025. The temporary suspension is intended to assist farmers facing low paddy rice prices during the current harvest season.

Low global prices and a reduced import tariff encouraged large volumes of rice imports. In June 2024, amid high domestic prices, the Philippines government reduced the Most Favored Nation import rate for rice from 35 to 15 percent¹. Since India's removal of its rice export ban in September 2024, global export prices have further declined. More than 3.3 million tons were exported to the Philippines in January-August 2025, mostly from Vietnam. Despite the harvest of the new crop, Philippines rice imports are expected to resume in November as global prices are expected to remain competitive to domestic supplies.

COARSE GRAINS

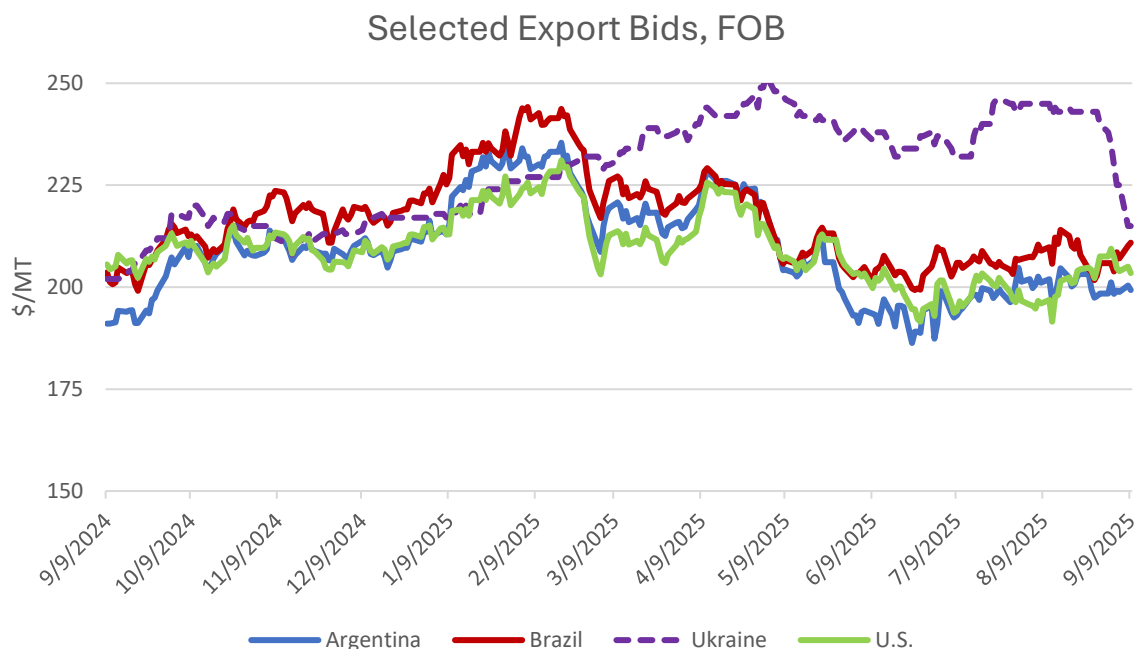
OVERVIEW FOR 2025/26

Global corn production is forecast down this month as cuts to the European Union, Serbia, and Russia more than offset higher production in Canada, India, and the United States. Global trade is up as the United States and Zambia are forecast to export more, outweighing lower exports from Serbia, the European Union, and Russia. Global imports are also forecast up on higher imports for the European Union. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$3.90 per bushel.

OVERVIEW FOR 2024/25

Global corn production is forecast up this month as higher production in Brazil and South Africa more than offsets lower production in Pakistan. Global trade is also raised as higher exports from the United States and the European Union more than offset cuts to Ukraine and Turkey. Global imports are forecast slightly down as a reduction to China more than offsets higher imports for Brazil and Venezuela. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$4.30 per bushel.

Global: Since the August *WASDE*, export bids for U.S. and Brazilian origins rose, while bids for Argentine and Ukrainian origins softened. Argentine bids fell \$4 to \$199/ton as exporters priced supplies competitively to attract demand. Brazilian bids were little changed as pressure from the strong second crop (*safrinha*) harvest was offset by strong domestic use and firm export demand. U.S. bids were up \$6 to \$203/ton as robust sales of new crop supplies continued to balance pressures from a massive forecast harvest. Ukrainian bids fell sharply by \$30 to \$215/ton as bids reflect greatly improved new crop supplies.

Beginning with the release of 2021/22 data, historical data for both EU27 and the UK are provided for 5 years (2016/17 through 2020/21). See below for notes on prior years’ EU Consolidated data.

OTHER NOTES

Marketing Years (MY): MY refers to the 12-month period at the onset of the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's MY for that commodity (2024/25 starts in 2024); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the MY (2024/25 starts in 2025). Prices: Many export bids and quotes in this publication are Free-On Board (FOB). FOB is a term of sale meaning that the shipper will pay all costs to deliver and load the cargo at a specified place, usually a ship, and then the receiver pays the costs from there on — normally the ocean freight, insurance, and all subsequent costs of unloading and delivery. All references to ton, unless otherwise specified, refer to metric tons – 2,204.62 U.S. pounds/1,000 kilograms.

Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

Trade: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year (TY 2024/25 corresponds to Jan – Dec 2025).

European Union:

From 2016/17 onwards, the European Union PSD data includes 27 member countries, excluding intra-trade between the member states. The trade figures starting from 1999/00 through 2015/16 represent the European Union (EU-27 plus UK) and excludes all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat (1001), flour (1101), bulgur (190430), and selected pasta products (190219, 190230, and 190240) on a grain-equivalent basis (all wheat flour and products are multiplied by 1.368). (2) Rice trade statistics include rough (100610), brown (100620), milled (100630), and broken (100640) on a milled-equivalent basis (rough rice is multiplied by 0.7 and brown rice is multiplied by 0.875). (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.

Information is gathered from official statistics of foreign governments and other foreign source materials, reports of U.S. agricultural attachés and Foreign Service officers, office research, and related information.
