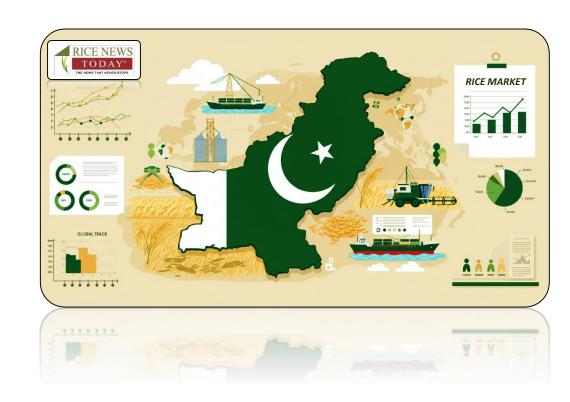

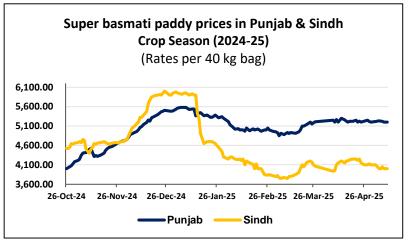

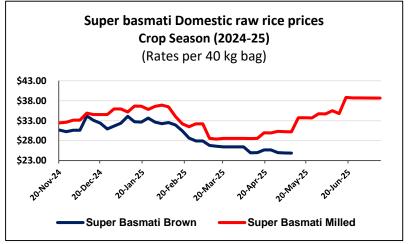

As the new crop reaches the market, genuine export prices between buyers and sellers will soon become clearer.</li> <li>In the first quarter of FY2025–26, Pakistan's rice exports declined sharply by 42% year-on-year, with Basmati exports down 43.6%. The downward trend continued in September 2025, as rice exports fell 59% year-on-year and 29% month-on-month, with Basmati down 42% YoY and 21% MoM.</li> </ul>

# EMERGING BASMATI VARIETIES FOR NEW SEASON CROP: 2025–26



With the onset of the **2025–26 kharif season**, discussions have intensified around the adoption of new and emerging basmati rice varieties. A notable trend this season is the increasing interest in **variety 1718**, which is reportedly being considered as a potential replacement for the widely cultivated **1121 basmati.**

- As sowing continues and harvesting begins by the end of this month, clearer insights will emerge regarding the scale of cultivation and performance of these varieties across key basmati-growing zones.

#### PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Rice Exporters Association of Pakistan (REAP) has protested its exclusion from the NAFSA Board, despite Prime Minister's clear orders for its inclusion. REAP emphasized that it represents USD 5.5 billion of Pakistan's USD 8 billion plant-based exports, including USD 3.5 billion in rice, making it the most qualified body for representation. Chairman Faisal warned that most SPS-related export issues arise from rice trade with sensitive markets like the EU, US, and Australia, and that excluding REAP violates fair stakeholder representation. He urged the government to honor the PM's directive and ensure REAP's rightful seat on the board. Read More (20th Oct).
- The Punjab Agriculture Department has signed four MoUs with Chinese firms to boost modern farming in the province. The agreements include satellite-based crop monitoring with Piesat Technology, joint establishment of a tractor and harvester plant with Gold Dafeng Machinery, and collaboration with a Chinese agricultural university to develop high-quality seeds and set up a centre of excellence for advanced research. - In Q1 FY2025–26, Pakistan's rice exports plunged 42% year-on-year, with Basmati down 43.6% and non-Basmati (IRRI-6 & IRRI-9) down 41.1%, contributing heavily to the country's widening trade deficit. In September 2025, rice exports further fell 59% YoY and 29% MoM with Basmati dropping 42% YoY (21% MoM) and non-Basmati collapsing 66% YoY (33% MoM) due to weak demand and flood-related disruptions. ## PAKISTAN is the 4<sup>th</sup> largest rice exporting country in the world.

- Basmati rice exports fell to 101,934 MT (\$107.29m) from 186,673 MT (\$192.61m) last year, marking a sharp decline of -45% in volume and -44% in value.
- Non-basmati exports stood at 443,469 MT (\$207.09m) versus 430,071 MT (\$272.06m) last year, with volume up +3% but value down -24%.
- Pakistan controls **67%** of the **basmati brown rice market** in the **European Union** and the **UK**.

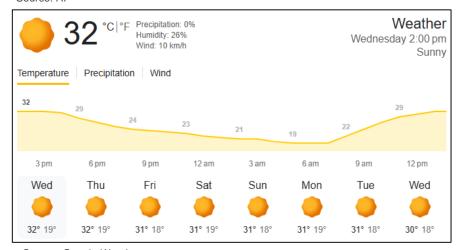
#### RICE FARMING IN PAKISTAN:

## The Paddy Price Trap: Why Sindh's Farmers Lose In A Market Without Rules:

- As the **paddy harves**t begins across lower **Sindh**, what should be a season of prosperity has instead become a cycle of frustration and protest. Farmers from districts like **Badin**, **Sujawal**, and **Thatta** accuse rice millers of unjustified deductions on the pretext of high moisture content and rigged weighing scales often recording **32–35 kilograms** as one maund instead of 40. These deductions, coupled with falling **market prices** that have plunged from **Rs 3,600** to as low **as Rs 2,000–2,200 per maund**, have left smallholders struggling to recover even their **production** costs. Despite record cultivation over **2.1 million acres in 2025**, growers say they remain trapped in a market that rewards middlemen and millers rather than those who till the land.
- Behind the crisis lies a deeper governance void. Sindh's agriculture department, meant to regulate moisture testing, pricing, and scale verification, has largely withdrawn from its oversight role allowing private millers and traders to dominate procurement. With no standardized testing or certified weighing system, farmers are left vulnerable to arbitrary deductions and collusive pricing. Even as Pakistan's rice exports touch US \$3.2 billion, the farmers who produce it continue to lose ground. Experts and grower associations now urge the government to establish district-level Rice Price & Quality Committees and standardize inspection systems to restore fairness and rebuild trust between farmers, millers, and the state..
- ✓ The current weather is ideal for the new crop, especially **basmati rice**, sunny days and cool evenings mark the onset of winter in Pakistan, supporting healthy crop growth and timely harvesting.

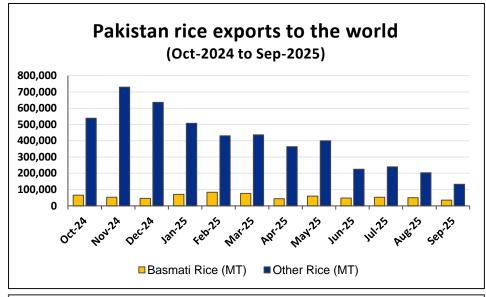

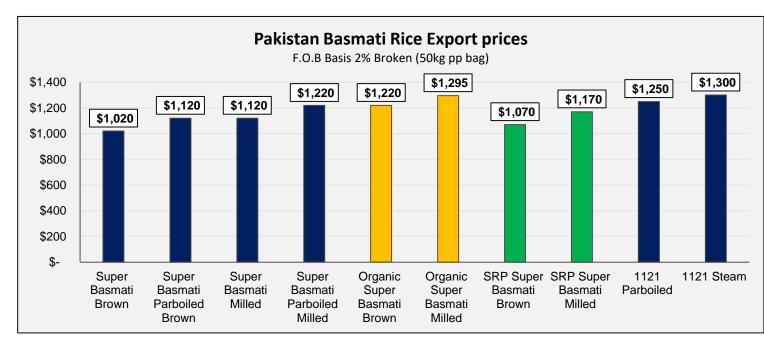

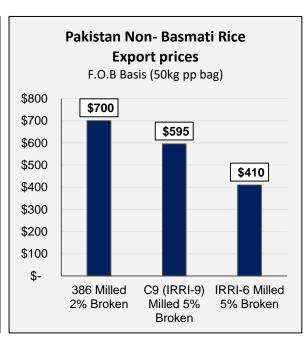

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EXPORT PRICES F.O.B BASIS (PER TON)



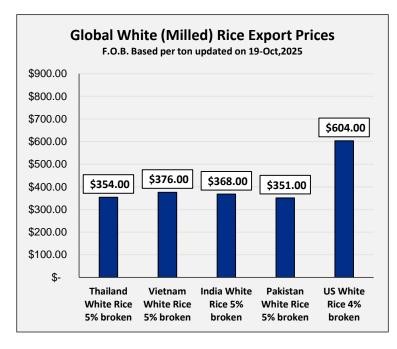




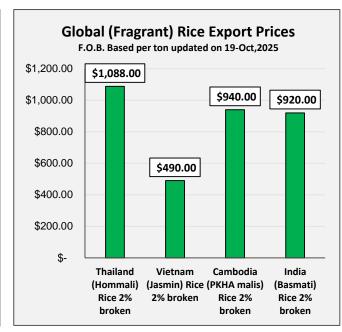

> As per the news the Asian rice prices continued to fall, with Thailand's 5% broken rice hitting an 18-year low at \$340-\$360/ton, its lowest since October 2007, amid weak global demand. India's 5% parboiled rice held steady at \$350-\$355/ton, near a nine-year low, while Vietnam's 5% broken rice at \$360-\$380/ton. In contrast, Bangladesh's domestic rice prices rose 15% year-on-year, driven by high input costs and market inefficiencies.

#### GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:



Basmati growers in Punjab and Haryana face heavy losses as prices have fallen by Rs 1,500 per quintal compared to last year. PUSA 1509 now sells at Rs 2,300–2,500/quintal and PUSA 1718 at up to Rs 3,300, down from Rs 4,000–4,700 in 2023. So far, 6.65 LMT of basmati paddy has arrived in mandis, with prices ranging between Rs 2,300 and Rs 3,800/quintal, hit by low export demand, West Asia conflict, and higher US tariffs. Vietnam is positioning itself as a global pillar of food security through rapid adoption of biotechnology and gene editing in agriculture. Producing over **34.8 million tons of rice** and exporting more than **7 million tons in 2025**, the country is advancing toward a **sustainable**, **high-tech**, **and bio-industrial agricultural model** backed by strong government policy support. Japan's average rice price fell for the fourth consecutive week to ¥4,142 per 5 kg, though it stayed above ¥4,000 for the sixth week in a row. The decline was driven by increased sales of blended rice (29% share, ¥3,419), while brand rice prices rose to ¥4,440 amid high demand for newly harvested varieties.. READ MORE (19-Oct)



In the first half of FY2025–26 (April–September), Myanmar exported over 1.2 million tonnes of rice and broken rice worth US\$408 million, with China importing over 1 million tonnes, making it the top buyer. Indonesia (267,882 tonnes) and the Philippines (211,464 tonnes) followed, as Myanmar targets 3 million tonnes of rice exports for the year. READ MORE (22-Oct)



A new US-Japan trade deal signed on July 22, 2025, requires Japan to import more American rice under its WTO quota, threatening to slash Thailand's annual quota from 300,000 tonnes to under 100,000 tonnes, a two-thirds reduction. Thailand's Commerce

Ministry is urgently negotiating to retain its share, as Thai rice exports to Japan have already fallen 19% in volume and 42% in value in the first seven months of 2025. READ MORE (16-Oct)

- Bangladesh's state grains buyer has issued an international tender to purchase
   50,000 metric tons of rice.
- o **Tender deadline:** November 3, 2025.
- The tender invites offers for non-basmati parboiled rice on a CIF liner out basis (seller covers ship unloading costs).
- o **Shipment requirement:** within 40 days after contract award.
- o **Delivery ports:** Chittagong and Mongla.
- o Rice can be sourced from any country except Israel.
- o Bangladesh has held **multiple rice import tenders** recently.
- Despite bumper harvests and increased local stocks, domestic rice prices remain high. Read More
