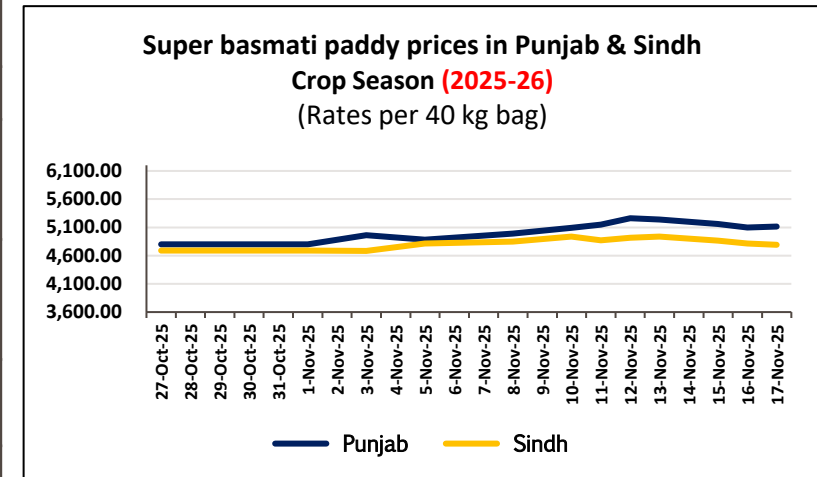

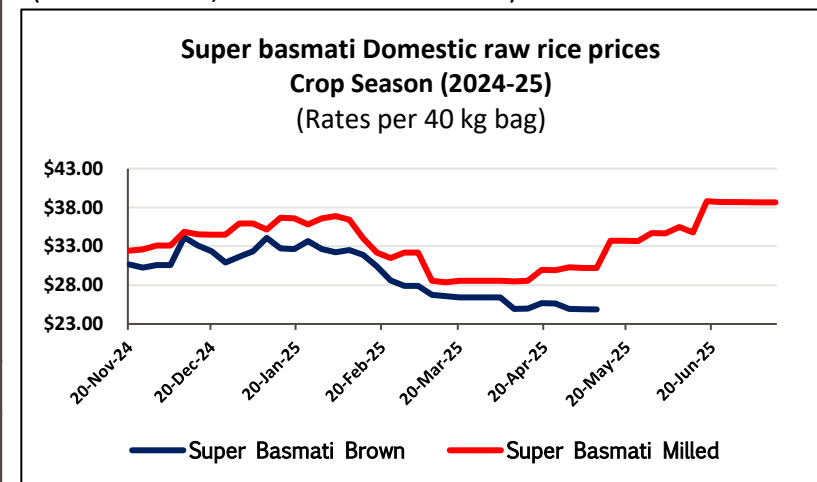

Supply and Demand	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> It has been reported that, Trade for Super Basmati has commenced, with two European buyers securing back-to-back shipments at \$780–\$830/ton (Super Basmati brown rice). Indian Pusa Basmati is trading at similar levels of \$790–\$850/ton. The Indian market remains firm, supported by Gulf buyers purchasing around 250,000 tons of parboiled and steam rice. In contrast, the Pakistani market is relatively soft due to competitive Indian prices. Both India and Pakistan have reported bumper basmati crops this year, with Pakistan’s crop showing excellent quality and higher yields compared to last year. Overall, rice trading has started actively in both countries, and strong business is anticipated for the basmati season. Current super Paddy rates are around PKR 5,000–5,200 per 40 kg, up from early arrivals at PKR 4,700–4,900.

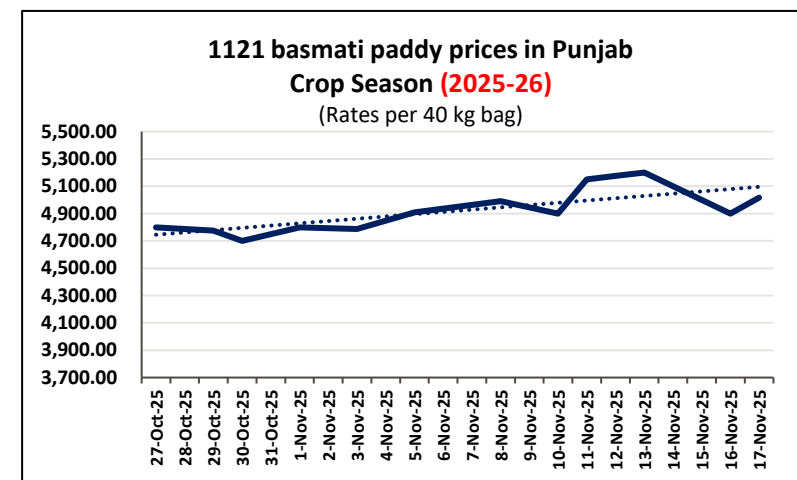

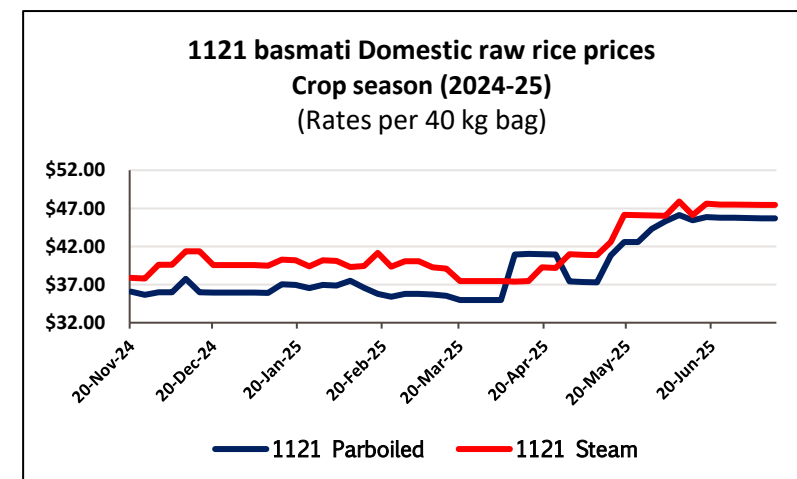

It remains to be seen whether these hybrids will be exported individually or blended with standard 1121. Overall, trade and export prospects for 1121 remain positive, and good business is expected this season. Current rates are hovering around PKR 4,800–4,900 per 40 kg, from early arrivals at PKR 4,700–4,800.

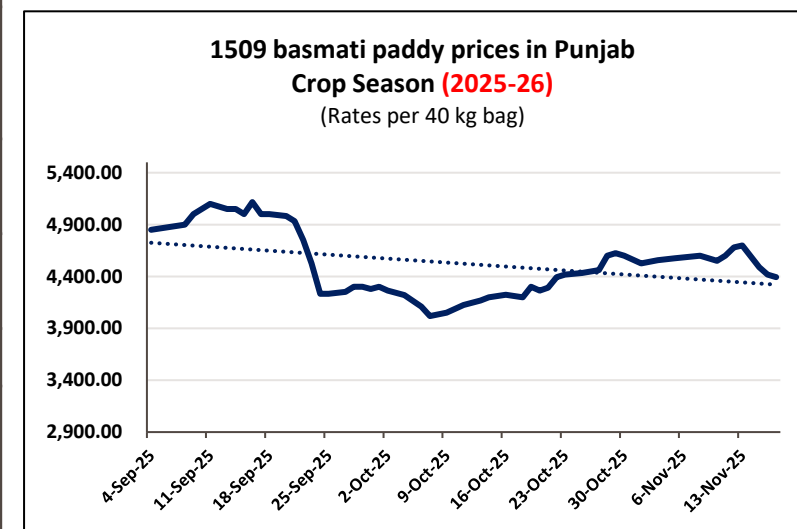

This season, several new hybrid types such as 1718, PB-7, and 1847 (hybrid of 1509) have also entered the market, and an overall good harvest is expected across all varieties.

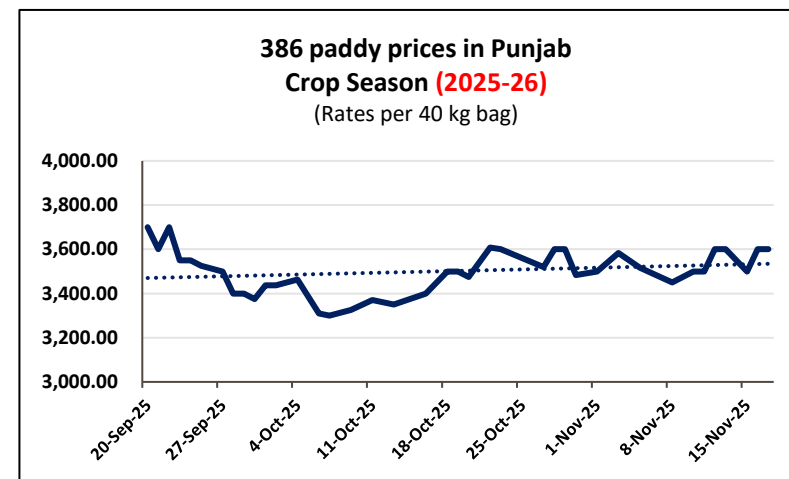

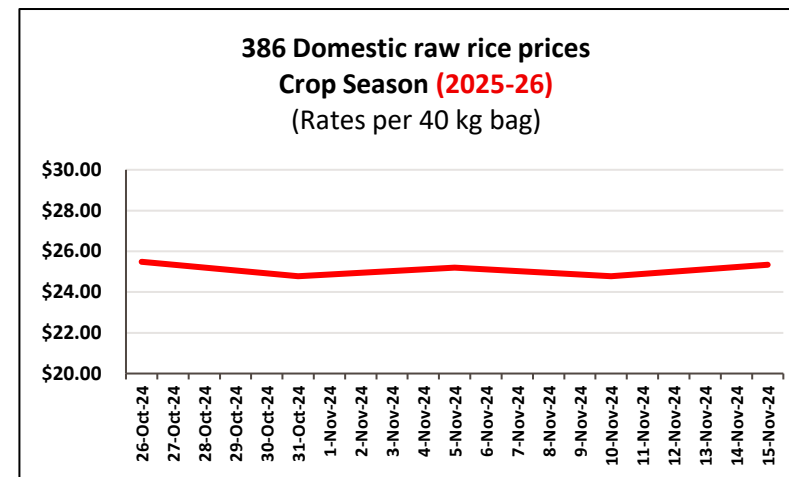

Current paddy prices range between PKR 3,500–3,600 per 40 kg, compared to last week levels of PKR 3,400–3,500 per 40 kg, Reflecting a stable momentum. • Domestic raw rice prices for 386 rice variety are around \$24.5–\$25.5 per 40 kg, equivalent to approximately PKR 7,000–7,200.

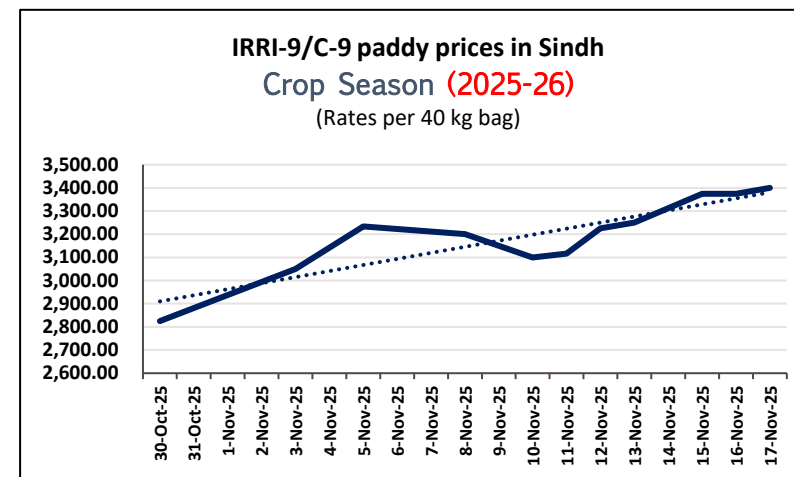

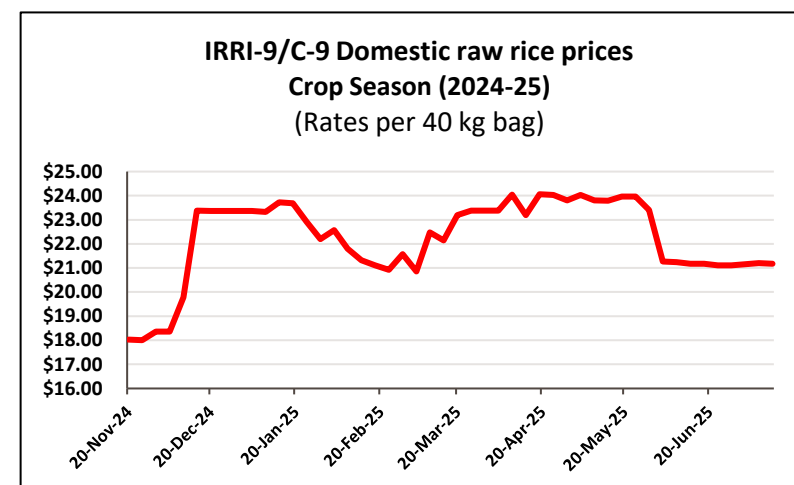

The paddy arrival of IRRI-9 has started in the market, with a bumper flow expected within a week. Local trade for IRRI-9 has commenced this season, and offers to international buyers are already underway. Current paddy prices range between PKR 3,200–3,400 per 40 kg up from last week levels of PKR 2,800–3,200 per 40 kg bag. Showing a notable increase in IRRI-9 Paddy prices.

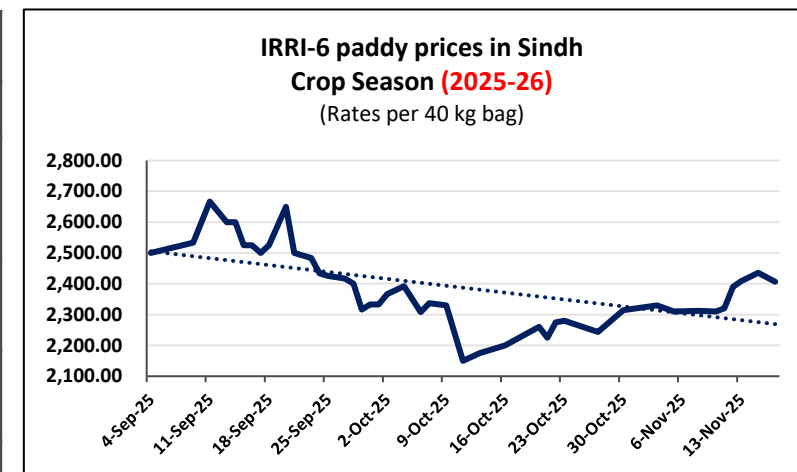


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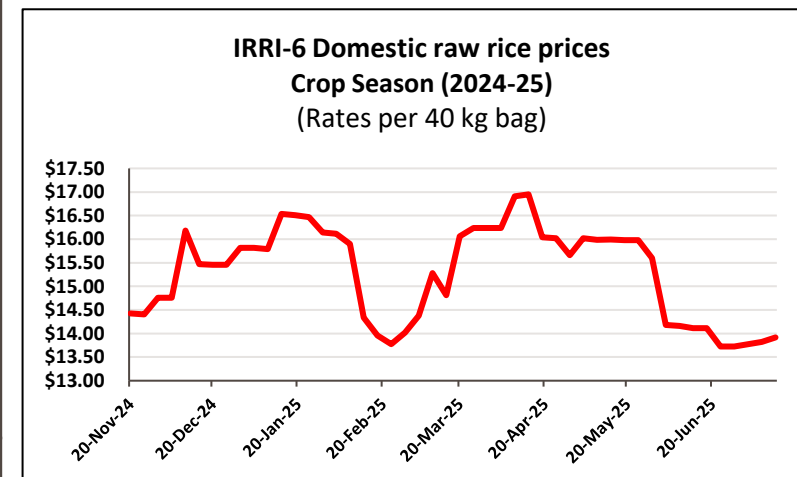

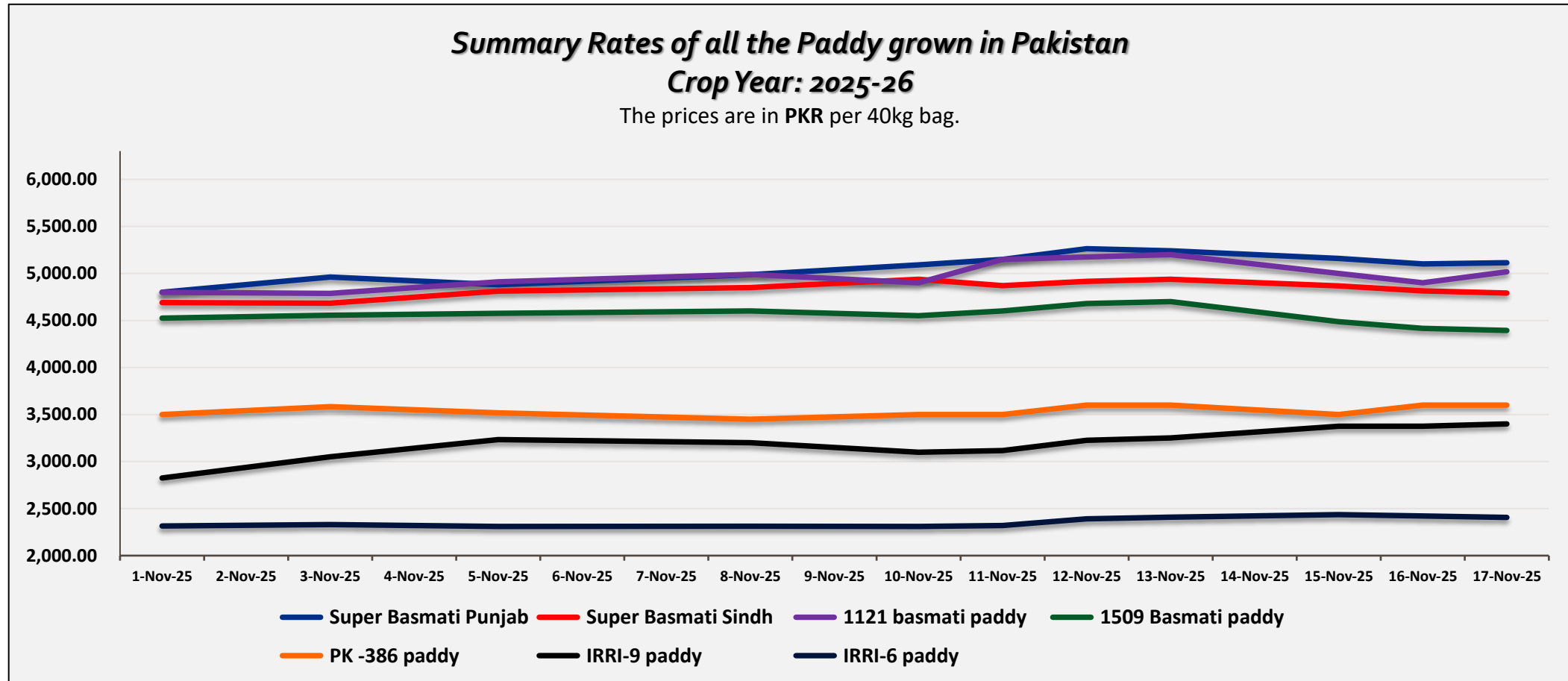

CROP: 2025–26



With the onset of the **2025–26 kharif season**, discussions have intensified around the adoption of new and emerging basmati rice varieties. A notable trend this season is the increasing interest in **variety 1718**, which is reportedly being considered as a potential replacement for the widely cultivated **1121 basmati**.

PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Pakistan's agricultural exports** declined by **3.4% in FY 2024-25**, mainly due to falling international prices after India lifted its rice export ban. Commerce **Minister Jam Kamal Khan** noted that the re-entry of **Indian agri-products**, particularly rice and onions, has created oversupply and reduced Pakistan's competitiveness in key farm commodities. While overall **exports slightly rose to \$32.04 billion**, weaknesses in the agriculture sector offset gains in textiles and IT. Regional transit challenges through Iran, Afghanistan, and Gulf routes also added pressure. Trade analysts warn that intensifying competition from India, Vietnam, and Myanmar could further impact **Pakistan's farm export earnings**. The situation highlights the vulnerability of Pakistan's export sector due to reliance on a limited range of agricultural commodities. [Read More](#) (20th Nov).
- **Pakistan** achieved a major legal victory in the global basmati rice dispute as the **New Zealand High Court** dismissed **India's appeal** for exclusive certification trademark rights. The court upheld the earlier decision by **New Zealand's** Intellectual Property Office, recognizing that basmati is grown in both Pakistan and India and cannot be exclusively associated with India. **India's APEDA** had sought sole rights since 2019, but the court ruled that restricting the term would unfairly disadvantage Pakistani exporters. The verdict reinforces **Pakistan's** legitimacy as a basmati producer and safeguards its access to **New Zealand's market**. Industry representatives welcomed the decision, noting it strengthens Pakistan's position in ongoing international basmati trademark disputes. [Read More](#) (16th Nov).



PAKISTAN is the 4th largest rice exporting country in the world.

- Total rice exports fell to **712,797 tonnes** in **Q1 FY26** from **991,146 tonnes** in **Q1 FY25**, a **28% decline**.
- Basmati rice exports fell to **137,066 tonnes** in **Q1 FY26** from **248,500 tonnes** last year, a **45.5% decline**.
- Non-basmati rice exports dropped to **575,731 tonnes** from **764,700 tonnes**, down **22.1%**.
- Pakistan controls **67%** of the **basmati brown rice market** in the **European Union** and the **UK**.

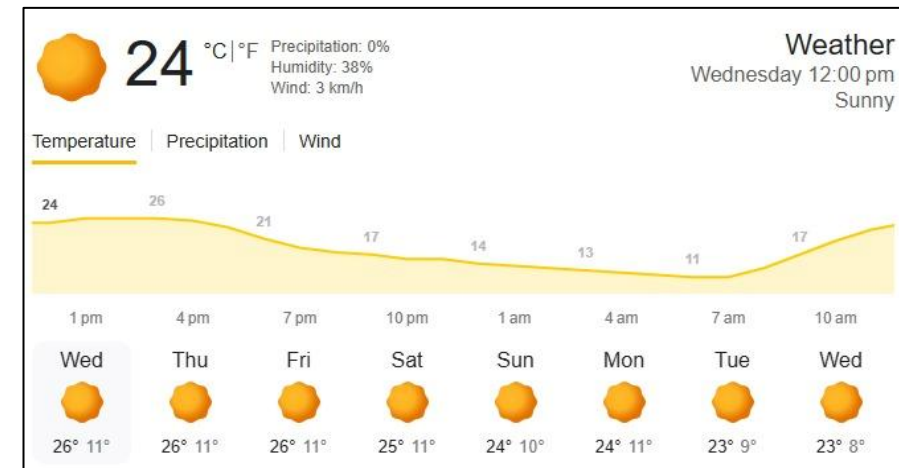
Sindh Pushes for Paddy Support Price and Direct Farmer Subsidies:

- The Sindh government has called on the federal authorities to establish a clear and effective mechanism for fixing the support price of paddy, similar to the system applied for wheat. Sindh's Agriculture Minister, Sardar Muhammad Bakhsh Mahar, highlighted the ongoing challenges faced by rice farmers in the province and stressed the importance of fair compensation for their hard work. To address these concerns, district-level committees have been formed, led by Assistant Commissioners and Market Committee secretaries, to monitor market practices, take action against exploitative middlemen, and ensure that farmers' complaints are addressed promptly. These committees will submit weekly reports to the Agriculture Secretary, creating a structured system of oversight aimed at protecting farmers' interests.
- In a bid to reduce production costs and improve profitability, the Sindh government has also decided to channel all agricultural subsidies through the Benazir Hari Card, creating a transparent and direct support system for small and marginalized farmers. The minister emphasized that while provincial governments cannot independently fix crop prices due to federal regulations and IMF agreements, a collaborative long-term agricultural strategy involving both federal and provincial authorities is essential. By combining direct financial assistance with improved monitoring of market practices, the Sindh government aims to safeguard farmers against unfair pricing, strengthen their livelihoods, and promote sustainable growth in the rice sector. *(14, November 2025)*

- This week, **Super Basmati** rice prices increased by \$20/ton across all categories, while **1121 Basmati parboiled and steam** saw a rise of \$35/ton. Among non-Basmati varieties, **IRRI-6 recorded a price increase of \$15/ton**, whereas PK-386 experienced a decline of \$40/ton. Export prices for IRRI-9 will be updated shortly.

EXPORT PRICES F.O.B BASIS (PER TON)





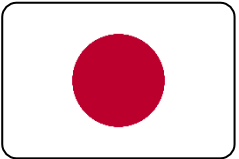

- As per the news, This week, **Thai 5% broken rice prices** fell to **\$355/ton**, the lowest since 2007, due to weak demand and abundant new-season supply. **Indian 5% broken parboiled** rice held steady at **\$344–\$350/ton**, while **5% broken white rice** remained at **\$350–\$360/ton**. **Vietnam's 5% broken rice** was stable at **\$365–\$375/ton** despite slow sales. Bangladesh approved importing parboiled rice at \$355.59/ton to stabilize local supply.

GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:

	<p>Thailand's rice exports fell 24% in 2024-25 to 7.5 million tonnes due to intense competition from India and Vietnam, particularly in white rice. While parboiled and fragrant rice performed better, overall exports are expected to remain the same in 2025-26. Production will dip slightly but strong ending stocks will help stabilize prices despite global competition. READ MORE (19-Nov)</p>
	<p>The Philippines has extended its ban on regular and well-milled rice imports until end-2025, creating risks for Việt Nam, which relies on the market for over 40% of its rice exports. Vietnamese exporters are shifting focus toward Africa and the Middle East as exports to the Philippines drop 27%, though Việt Nam still maintains strong competitiveness with higher export prices than regional rivals. 	<p>Vietnam's VFA chairman says Vietnam has many high-quality rice varieties but weak branding and no long-term strategy limit global recognition. Despite ST25 winning the World's Best Rice Award 2025, it remains unfamiliar to many consumers, underscoring the need for national-level branding, protection and coordinated promotion to elevate Vietnamese premium rice worldwide. 	<p>India's bid to secure exclusive rights to the term basmati was rejected by the New Zealand High Court, which ruled the name is descriptive and applies to rice grown in both India and Pakistan. The decision prevents India from restricting basmati sales to its own varieties and aligns with similar rulings in Australia. READ MORE (20-Nov)</p>
	<p>Japan's editorial board warns that current rice policy is confused, as prices remain high despite increased supply. The new minister's "production in line with demand" approach risks repeating past misjudgments that caused shortages, and policymakers are urged to support farmers while ensuring consumers are protected from excessively high prices. GLOBAL RICE TENDER & TRADE UPDATE:

Bangladesh Moves to Strengthen Rice Supplies with New Tenders and Imports Ahead of Ramadan:

- The government has approved the **import of 50,000 MT of non-Basmati parboiled rice** through an international tender at **\$354.19/ton** to strengthen food supplies ahead of Ramadan. The shipment will be managed by **M/S Aditya Birla Global Trading (Singapore)**, with an estimated cost of **Tk 216.90 crore**. Authorities have also eased LC restrictions and initiated imports of rice and wheat to stabilize prices, while expediting procurement timelines to meet rising domestic demand.

(19, November 2025)

- Bangladesh's state grains buyer has issued a new international tender to purchase **50,000 metric tons** of rice.
- Price offers must be submitted by **December 1** and remain **valid until December 15**.
- The tender requests **non-Basmati parboiled** rice on CIF liner out terms, with shipment to Chittagong and Mongla ports 40 days after contract award.
- Rice can originate from any country except Israel.
