





Punjab's harvest is over, and stocks lie with exporters and stockiest, though two major EU buyers are present in market for back-to-back shipments but no sizeable trade is observed yet. Market correction is likely as Sindh arrivals peak. Current super Paddy rates are around PKR 4,800–5,000 per 40 kg, stable with the last week level of paddy prices.





However, buyers continue shifting toward India due to more competitive pricing there. Pakistani sales may improve if any downward price correction appears locally. Overall, routine sale purchase continues without any major fluctuations. Meanwhile a major Indian deal of around 200,000 tonnes of Pusa parboiled for Saudi Arabia and Turkey pushed domestic Pusa paddy to INR 35,000/quintal, raising FOB levels. Current rates are hovering around PKR 5,000–5,200 per 40 kg, Stable with earlier paddy prices.





Additionally, exporters in Pakistan are clubbing new varieties such as 1847 and 1692 with 1509 Basmati, as these variants are entering the market in good quantities. While it is still unclear whether they will form their own export category in the future, they are attracting growers due to better yield potential and improved grain quality.



Key buyers like the Philippines (import ban) and Indonesia (not purchasing) have further softened demand, increasing competitive pressure on Pakistan. PK 386 paddy has begun arriving, with current rates at PKR 3,600–3,700 per 40 kg, slightly higher than last week's PKR 3,500–3,600, reflecting stable momentum. Domestic raw rice prices stand at \$24.5–\$25.5 per 40 kg, roughly PKR 7,000–7,200.

Bangladesh's multiple tenders and Pakistan's TCP tender for 100,000 tonnes of IRRI-6 may provide temporary demand support. The IRRI-6 variety has also started arriving in the market, with current paddy prices ranging between PKR 2,300–2,400 per 40 kg, Market conditions are seeming to be stabilizing.



- Exporters of Pakistan may club these new varieties with traditional Super, 1121, and 1509 Basmati. Although it is still unclear whether these varieties will form an individual export category, yet they are now arriving in the market in good quantities.
- These varieties are gaining attraction among growers due to certain agronomic benefits such as Improved yield potential & Better grain quality for export markets.

Using certified varieties not only ensures better productivity but also strengthens Pakistan's position in the global basmati rice market by maintaining consistency, quality, and authenticity.

PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- The **Trading Corporation of Pakistan (TCP)** has issued a tender to purchase **100,000 tonnes** of **long grain white rice (IRRI-6)** for export to **Bangladesh**, with bids due by **November 28**. This follows improved **Pakistan–Bangladesh ties since August 2024** and builds on previous government-to-government rice trade. Pakistan's rice exports fell **28% in Q1 FY26** due to policy changes and India's export resumption, but Pakistan retained its share in high-end markets, aided by **US tariffs on Indian basmati**. The tender aims to supply Bangladeshi imports from Pakistan's latest crop, reinforcing trade cooperation. [Read More](#) (26th Nov).
- During the first four months of **FY 2025-26 (July–October)**, Pakistan exported **998,063 metric tons** of rice valued at **\$581.169 million**, down **46.4%** from **1,595,361 tons** worth **\$1.084 billion** in the same period last year. **Basmati rice exports** earned **\$202.355 million (182,807 tons)**, while **non-Basmati rice** totaled **815,256 tons** worth **\$378.815 million**, both showing significant declines. Overall food **exports fell 34.93%** to **\$1.538 billion**, Month-on-month, food exports rose 28.59% in October 2025 to \$430.260 million, though still down 42.51% YoY. [Read More](#) (25th Nov).
- Pakistan** raised concerns with the **Netherlands** over the **basmati rice geographical indication (GI)** dispute with India, **rejecting India's claim to exclusive rights**. The country highlighted the untapped potential of **rice exports to the Dutch market**. Both sides discussed support for broader trade cooperation, including in agriculture. - India's FTA with the UK** and relaxed **MRLs** have boosted its rice exports, prompting **Pakistan's NA committee** to push for similar trade opportunities and stronger research on **climate-resilient rice varieties**. The committee urged closer public–private collaboration to enhance production, quality, and export competitiveness. The **Seed Association of Pakistan** also strongly opposed introducing **GMO** corn, arguing that non-GMO maize already performs better and faces no major pest threats. [Read More](#) (22nd Nov).



PAKISTAN is the 4th largest rice exporting country in the world.

- Total rice exports fell to **712,797 tonnes** in **Q1 FY26** from **991,146 tonnes** in **Q1 FY25**, a **28% decline**.
- Basmati rice exports fell to **137,066 tonnes** in **Q1 FY26** from **248,500 tonnes** last year, a **45.5% decline**.
- Non-basmati rice exports dropped to **575,731 tonnes** from **764,700 tonnes**, down **22.1%**.
- Pakistan controls **67%** of the **basmati brown rice market** in the **European Union** and the **UK**.


RICE FARMING IN PAKISTAN:

China to Establish High-Tech Farm Machinery Plants in Punjab:

- **Punjab's agricultural** landscape is set for a major transformation as a high-level Chinese delegation, visiting the province on the invitation of the **Punjab agriculture minister**, announced plans to establish manufacturing plants for advanced **agricultural machinery**. During a meeting in Lahore with senior officials, including Punjab Secretary Agriculture Iftikhar Ali Sahoo and Secretary Livestock Ahmad Aziz, the delegation revealed that these locally produced **Chinese machines** will be designed to fit the purchasing power of farmers while aligning with the region's farming needs. The initiative also promises export opportunities, along with close collaboration between Chinese experts and **Punjab's agricultural** scientists for technological training and capacity building. The meeting also reviewed the performance of working groups formed between Chinese companies and the Agriculture Department.
- Iftikhar Ali Sahoo shared that Punjab's recent visit to **China** resulted in the signing of five key MoUs covering **satellite-based crop monitoring**, cotton revival, seed research, technical assistance for a centre of excellence, and a high-tech mechanization program. He noted that recommendations for these agreements have already been finalized and emphasized Punjab's strong potential for adopting advanced mechanized farming practices. Supported by the **Chief Minister's vision and resources**, the province aims to modernize agriculture with China's help an agricultural powerhouse known for innovation. The Chinese delegation reaffirmed this commitment, stating that practical steps have begun to adopt aspects of **China's agricultural model in Punjab**, paving the way for deeper cooperation and long-term modernization of the province's farming sector. 







EXPORT PRICES F.O.B BASIS (PER TON)




Global White (Milled) Rice Export Prices

F.O.B. Based per ton updated on 24-Nov,2025




Global (Parboiled) Rice Export Prices

- As per the news, **Vietnam's rice prices** fell to a near five-year low, with **5% broken rice offered at \$360–\$365/ton** due to **weak demand** and buyers boosting domestic production. **India's 5% broken parboiled rice** rose to **\$352–\$360/ton** amid government procurement, while **Thailand's 5% broken rice** edged up to **\$360/ton**. Bangladesh approved the purchase of **50,000 tons of parboiled rice** at **\$354.19/ton** to help lower domestic prices.

GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:



India's kharif rice production for 2025-26 reached a record **124.5 million tonnes**, up **1.4%** from **122.8 million tonnes** last year. Total kharif food grain output rose to **173.3 million tonnes** from **169.5 million tonnes**, supported by a generally good monsoon despite localized excessive rainfall. [READ MORE](#) (27-Nov)



Thailand and China are set to finalize an MoU for the sale of **500,000 tonnes** of **Thai rice** during the Mekong–Lancang Cooperation forum on **Dec 14**, highlighting growing bilateral trade ties. The rice agreement will be the central focus of discussions between Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul and Chinese Premier Li Qiang. This deal strengthens **China's rice import supply** while deepening agricultural **cooperation with Thailand**. [READ MORE](#) (26-Nov)



Despite a sharp fall in **international rice prices from Thailand, India, and Vietnam** over the past year, retail and wholesale rice prices in **Bangladesh** have continued to rise, with fine rice increasing from **Tk72.67/kg** to **Tk77.10/kg** between **October 2024 and October 2025**. Experts attribute this disconnect to **high-profit motives** of traders, **market control by major millers**, and delays in imports reaching consumers, leaving domestic prices largely unaffected by global declines. The **Thailand Development Research Institute (TDRI)** warned that the government's **3 million-tonne rice absorption scheme** could repeat the flaws of the **previous rice pledging program**, risking corruption, overstocking, and disrupted exports. Higher scheme prices may reduce **Thailand's competitiveness against major exporters like Vietnam, India, and Pakistan**. TDRI urged reliance on market forces to prevent long-term damage to domestic and export rice markets. [READ MORE](#) (27-Nov)



Indonesia has banned rice imports due to abundant domestic reserves and a projected **2025 output of 34.8 million tonnes**, making imports unnecessary. The move is already impacting **global markets**, lowering rice prices from **Vietnam** and **Thailand**, and may shift regional **trade dynamics**. Advanced irrigation and **high-yield seed programs** underpin Indonesia's strong production and self-sufficiency. [READ MORE](#) (26-Nov)

GLOBAL RICE TENDER & TRADE UPDATE:

Bangladesh Ramps Up Rice Imports Amid Falling Stocks and Expanding Tender Activity:

- **Pakistan's TCP** has issued a tender to **export 100,000 tonnes of IRRI-6 white rice to Bangladesh**, with bid submissions due on **November 20**. This follows improving **Pakistan–Bangladesh ties** and earlier **50,000-tonne G2G rice trade**, signaling growing bilateral cooperation in food supplies. *(27, November 2025)*
- Bangladesh has issued a **new international tender to buy 50,000 metric tons of rice**, with price bids due on **December 9**, traders said. This comes alongside another ongoing tender for **50,000 tons closing on December 1**, adding to multiple tenders floated in November. *(25, November 2025)*
- Bangladesh's government has decided to import **300,000 tons of rice as national stocks** have fallen to **1.2 million tons**, down from **2.1 million tons** just three months ago. Officials say the move aims to stabilise prices and support the expanded food assistance Programme, though analysts argue that with Aman harvesting underway, large-scale imports may be unnecessary and could hurt local farmers. The government has also approved **50,000 tons of parboiled rice from Singapore's AGBT at USD 354.19/ton**. *(20, November 2025)*
- Bangladesh imported **13,528 tonnes of coarse rice from India through Benapole** in four months (Aug 21–Nov 18), transported in **395 trucks across 145 consignments**. Monthly imports were **1,260 tonnes in August, 5,435 in September, 5,188 in October, and 1,645 in November**. Officials say the resumed imports have already caused a slight drop in both wholesale and retail rice prices. *(20, November 2025)*
