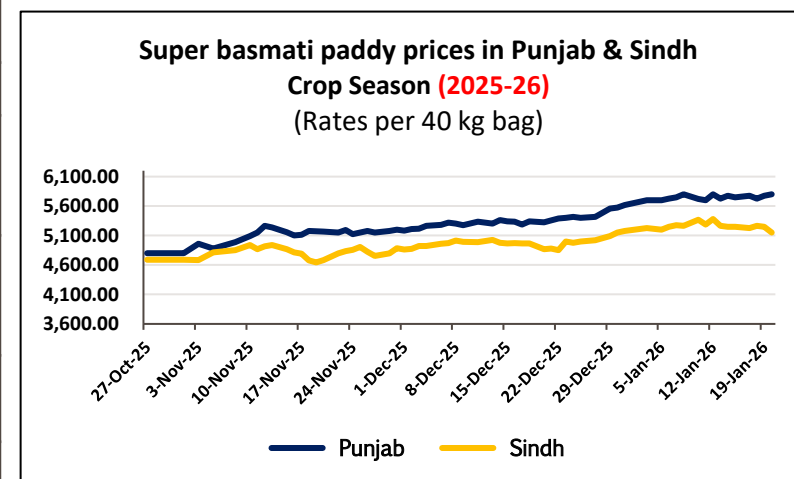

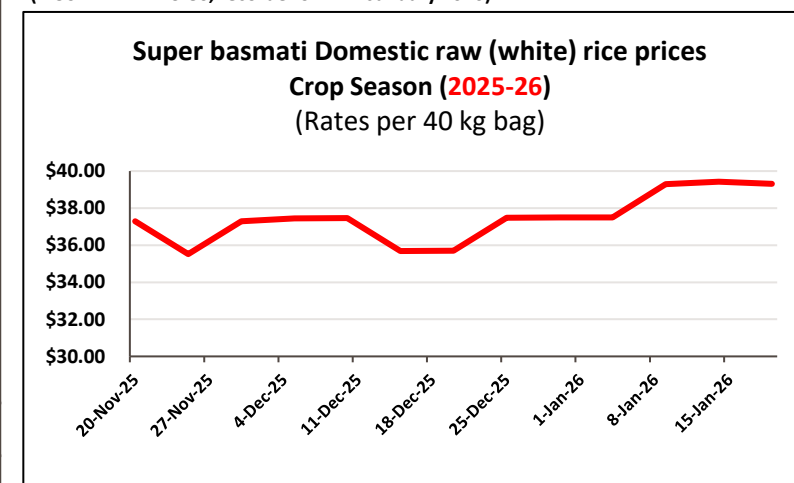

Current Super Basmati offers are around \$900/ton, with the Gulfood 2026 fair taking place this week, presenting fresh opportunities for rice exports. Looking ahead, Ramadan is expected to follow shortly after Gulfood, when Gulf countries traditionally increase rice purchases. As stockiest begin selling in anticipation of Ramadan and post-Eid demand, a market correction is likely in the coming days. Locally, Super Basmati paddy prices are hovering around PKR 5,700–5,800 per 40 kg in Punjab, stable with earlier prices.

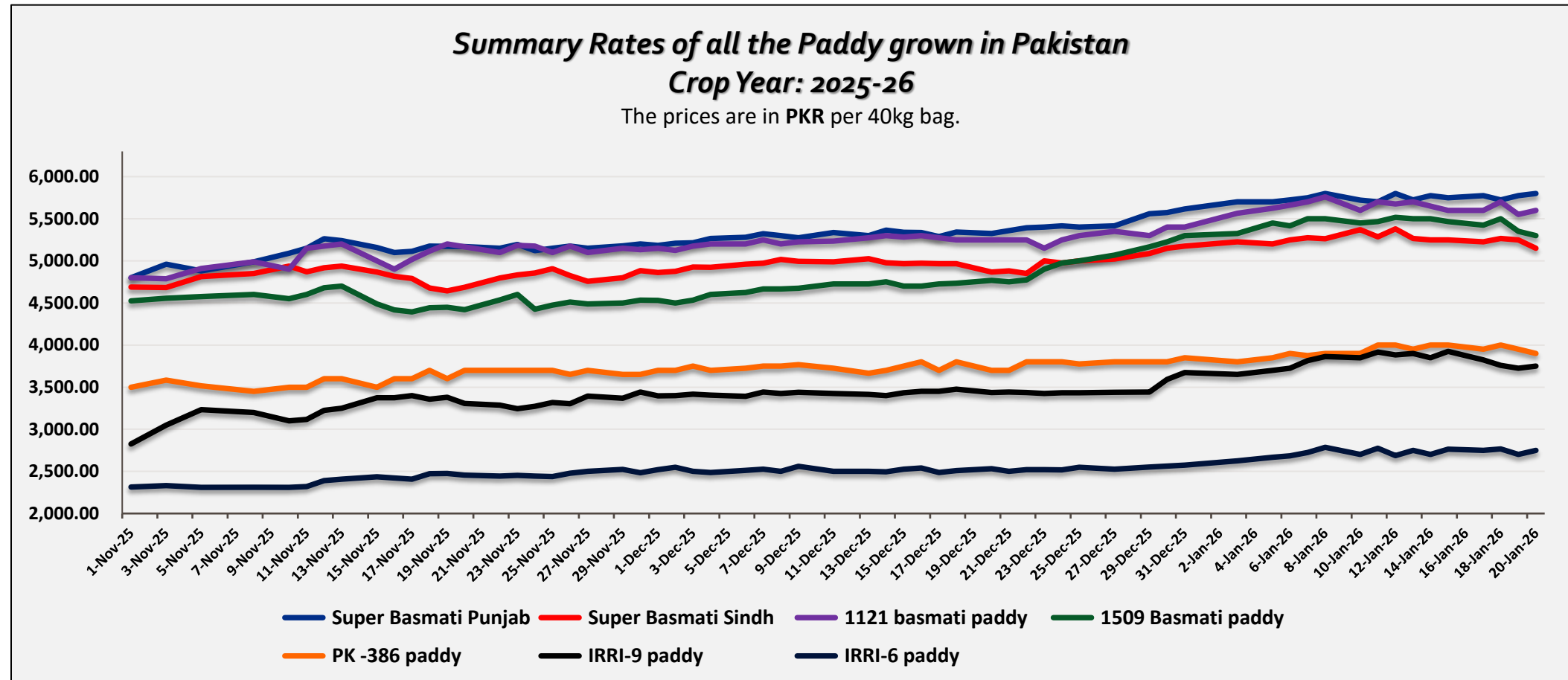

- ❑ Exporters of Pakistan may club these new varieties with traditional Super, 1121, and 1509 Basmati. Although it is still unclear whether these varieties will form an individual export category, yet they are now arriving in the market in good quantities.
- ❑ These varieties are gaining attraction among growers due to certain agronomic benefits such as Improved yield potential & Better grain quality for export markets.

Using certified varieties not only ensures better productivity but also strengthens Pakistan's position in the global basmati rice market by maintaining consistency, quality, and authenticity.

PAKISTAN NEWS HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Pakistan** has urged Indonesia to early-finalise a **rice export MoU** on a **government-to-government basis**, reviving a 2015 agreement that allowed up to **1 million tonnes** annually and expired in 2019. Commerce **Minister Jam Kamal Khan** said rice exports are a top priority, as Pakistan seeks to re-engage key partners like Indonesia through price-competitive, reliable, and quality-driven trade frameworks. - **Pakistan's rice export** growth is underpinned by a **20% expansion in cultivation area** and an expected output of **11 million metric tons**, leaving an exportable surplus of about **8 million tons**. However, the shift toward water-intensive non-Basmati rice enabled by nearly **650,000 solar-powered tubewells** is accelerating groundwater depletion and sidelining **premium Basmati**, raising long-term sustainability concerns. - **Pakistan** and **Indonesia** agreed to deepen trade ties with a renewed focus on rice, including early meetings of the **Joint Trade and Development Committee** and trade forums. **Pakistan** highlighted its position as a leading **rice exporter** and pushed for early finalization of a revised rice **MoU originally signed in 2015** for up to **1 million metric tons** annually to institutionalize long-term cooperation, while also raising concerns over agricultural market access issues. - **Pakistan's rice exports** rose **14% month-on-month** in **December 2025** to a record **489,000 tonnes**, driven by a **50%+ surge in Basmati shipments**, pushing **Pakistan past Vietnam (387,000 tonnes)** to rank as the **world's third-largest exporter**. The **UAE topped** destinations with **74,897 tonnes**, followed by **China (74,685 tonnes)**, while Central Asia emerged as a new growth area, with Kazakhstan importing over **17,000 tonnes**, including **10,300 tonnes** of Basmati. PAKISTAN is the 4th largest rice exporting country in the world.

- Total rice exports fell to **712,797 tonnes** in **Q1 FY26** from **991,146 tonnes** in **Q1 FY25**, a **28% decline**.
- Basmati rice exports fell to **137,066 tonnes** in **Q1 FY26** from **248,500 tonnes** last year, a **45.5% decline**.
- Non-basmati rice exports dropped to **575,731 tonnes** from **764,700 tonnes**, down **22.1%**.
- Pakistan controls **67%** of the **basmati brown rice market** in the **European Union** and the **UK**.

RICE FARMING IN PAKISTAN:

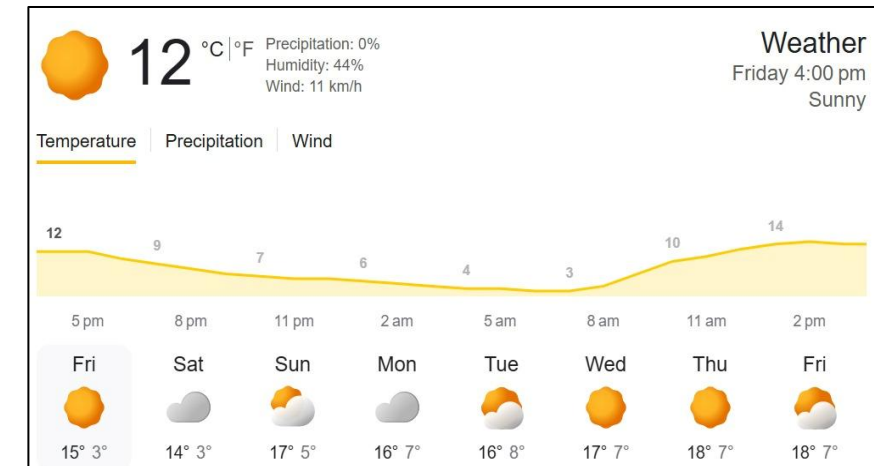
Pakistan's Rice Boom: Growth Today, Water Crisis Tomorrow:

- **Pakistan's agricultural** story over the past few decades has been one of effort without proportionate reward, and rice sits at the heart of this paradox. Policies long focused on boosting yields through better seeds, fertilizers and pest control, yet progress has remained slow. **Rice yields** have grown at an annual rate of just **1.38%**, far below population growth, pushing farmers to compensate through area expansion and more intensive cropping. In many districts, solar-powered tubewells and short-duration rice varieties such as **Basmati 1509** have enabled double and even triple cropping systems, embedding rice into tight rotations like **wheat, sesame, Basmati**. These farmer-led adjustments have raised output and **exports**, but they have also deepened dependence on a water-intensive crop at a time when irrigation supplies are under mounting strain.
- Behind this rise in **rice production** lies a more troubling narrative. Decades of underinvestment in **agricultural research** have left **Pakistan** ill-equipped to develop climate-resilient, **high-yielding rice varieties**, while **post-harvest losses** of up to **10%** for grains erode hard-won gains. **Traditional Basmati Pakistan's** most valuable rice asset remains confined to limited districts, with little varietal innovation and weak global branding. Meanwhile, low-value staples like rice and wheat still dominate **over 90%** of cropped area, restricting income growth. The authors argue **Pakistan's future** lies not in growing more rice alone, but in producing it more sustainably protecting water resources, reducing losses, strengthening export access, and gradually shifting toward **higher-value crops** and **Agro-processing**. Without this pivot, today's rice-driven gains risk becoming tomorrow's vulnerability. *(20, January 2026)*

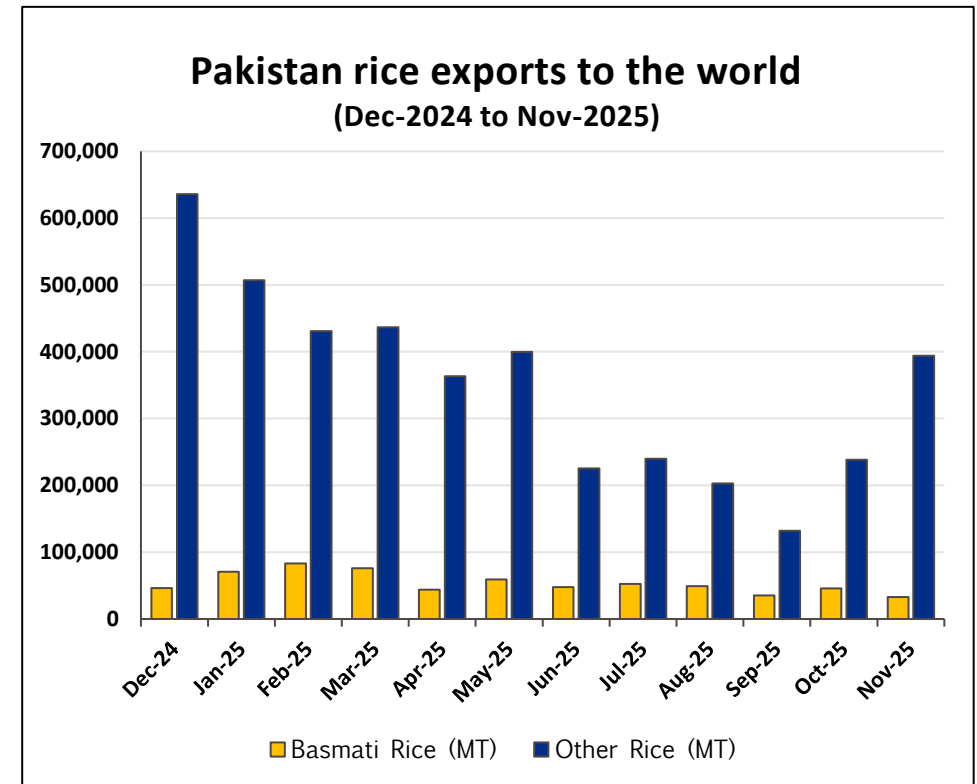

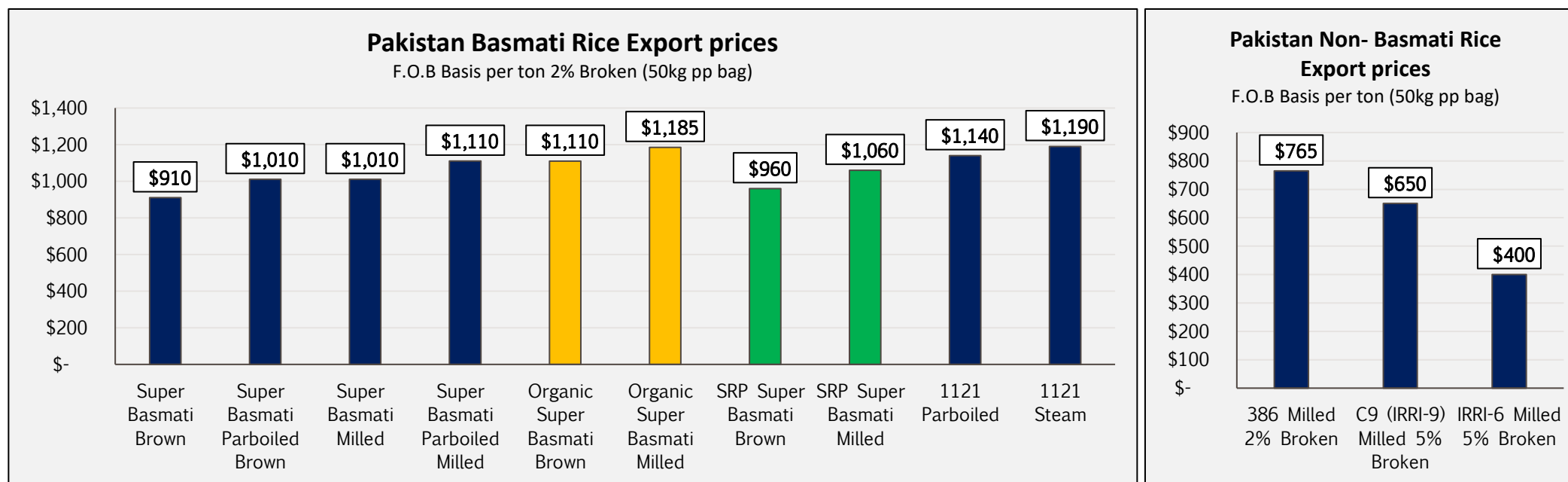


Pakistan Rice Production Area (2025-26)

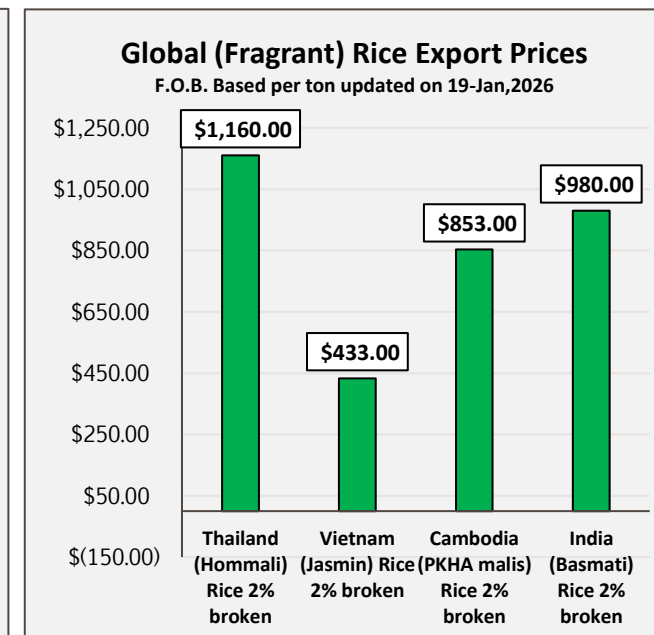
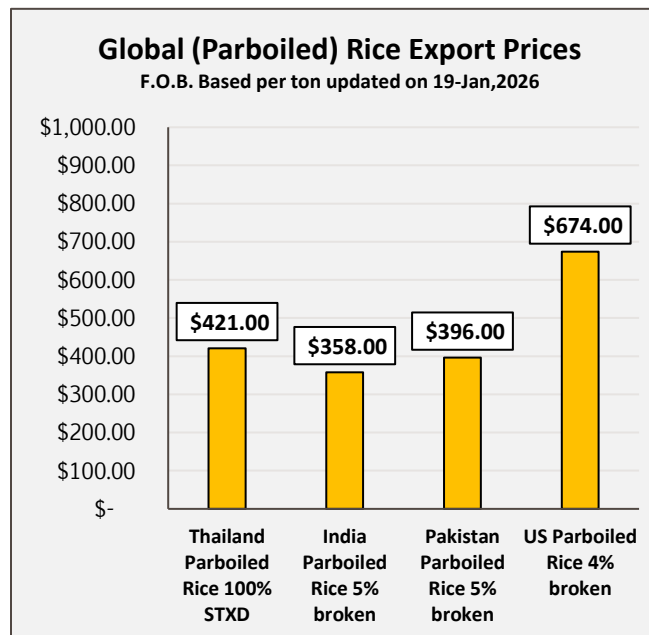
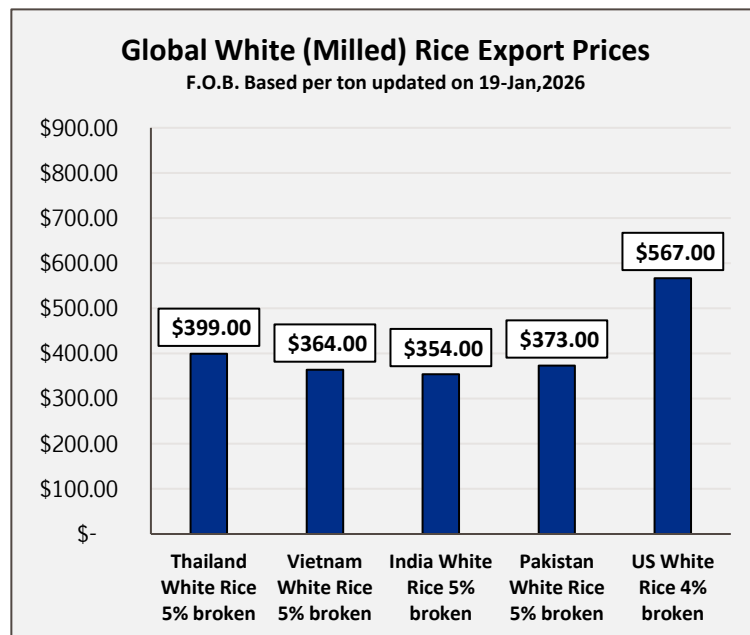
All Rice Prices were updated on 19th January 2026.

This week, prices for all major rice varieties remained high, with increase of **\$15/ton** in **Super Basmati** and **\$5/ton** increase in **1121 Basmati (parboiled and steam)**, **non-Basmati Long Grain - 386, IRRI-9** and **IRRI-6** white rice all saw slight movements, reflecting a steady market.

- As per the news, **Rice export prices** from **India** and **Thailand** edged lower this week amid weak demand and market inactivity, while **Vietnamese prices** remained flat. **India's 5% broken rice** slipped to \$350–\$358/ton, **Thailand's** to \$390–\$399/ton and **Vietnam's 5% broken** held steady at \$362–\$366/ton, with global prices expected to stay under pressure into 2026.

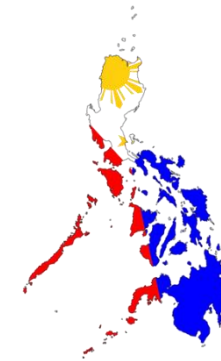
GLOBAL NEWS HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS WEEK:

	<p>Thailand's rice exports in 2025 reached 7.9 million tonnes, exceeding the 7.5 million-tonne target, with white rice leading despite a year-on-year drop. Key markets included Iraq, South Africa, the US, and China, while 2026 is expected to see fierce price competition and a forecast of 7 million tonnes, with the Thai government promoting exports through G2G deals, premium markets, and trade initiatives. 	<p>Vietnam's rice exports are projected at 7.73 million tonnes in 2026, with around 75% being high-quality and fragrant rice. Exports are expected to peak in early and mid-2026, following 8.06 million tonnes exported in 2025, which earned \$4.1 billion highlighting Vietnam's continued significance in the global rice market. 	<p>India is seeking new markets for its basmati rice as political unrest, economic instability, and US tariffs in Iran disrupt exports and delay payments. Exporters are now targeting Africa, West Asia, and Europe especially Nigeria to mitigate risks and maintain revenue from India's rice surplus. READ MORE (20-Jan)</p>
	<p>The Philippines' rice production rose 3% to 19.68 million metric tons (MMT) in 2025, up from 19.09 MMT in 2024, but remained below the 2023 record of 20.06 MMT. Irrigated farms grew 4% to 15.15 MMT, while rainfed farms slightly declined to 4.52 MMT. Corn output also increased 2.22% to 8.32 MMT, with yellow corn at 6.36 MMT and white corn at 1.96 MMT. 	<p>Rice prices in Dhaka's markets remained high, with old Miniket rice selling at Tk 75–85/kg and local Nazirshail at Tk 72–85/kg, up Tk 3–4 from two weeks ago, while newly arrived Miniket was cheaper at Tk 70–74/kg. Coarse rice prices stayed stable at Tk 50–60/kg, reflecting higher wholesale costs and continued consumer preference for older varieties. READ MORE (17-Jan)</p>

GLOBAL RICE TENDER & TRADE UPDATE:

Philippines to Import 2.5 Million Tonnes of Rice from Vietnam in 2026

- Vietnam is set to export **2.5 million tonnes** of rice to the **Philippines in 2026**, which plans to import a total of **3.6 million tonnes** this year, mostly from **Vietnam**. The **Philippines** had suspended **rice imports** for the last four months of 2025 to support **domestic production** and will implement measures, including tariffs, to control import volumes. *(19, January 2026)*



Pakistan Pushes for Early Rice Export MoU with Indonesia

- **Pakistan** has urged **Indonesia** to finalize a **government-to-government (G2G) MoU** for **rice exports**, originally signed in 2015 for up to **1 million tonnes annually**, which expired in 2019. **Commerce Minister Jam Kamal** highlighted Pakistan's priority on **rice exports**, emphasizing quality, reliability, and competitiveness, while sharing a revised draft with Indonesia to institutionalize long-term trade cooperation. *(21, January 2026)*



Bangladesh Resumes Rice Imports from India, Approves 2 Lakh Tonnes for Private Traders

- **Rice imports from India to Bangladesh resumed** at Hili land port after a **120-day suspension**, with **243 tonnes of coarse rice** arriving in the first shipment and **40 importers** authorized to bring in a total of **17,000 tonnes**. The Bangladeshi government has also issued fresh permits for private traders to import **2 lakh tonnes of parboiled rice**, bringing total import permissions this fiscal year to **8 lakh tonnes**, while public stocks stand at **18.71 lakh tonnes**. Imported rice is priced lower (**Tk 64–65/kg**) than local coarse rice (**Tk 70–71/kg**), and all imports must be **sold by March 10** under regulatory conditions. *(22, January 2026)*
